Advisory on testing of Expatriates screened positive for IgM at Airport

No 31/F2/2020/ Health- 25th June 2020

The Government Order (Rt) No 380/2020/NORKA dated 24th June 2020 has been issued to screen expatriates arriving at airports in Kerala with the Antibody tests. In this context, following advisory is issued regarding testing of expatriates who screened positive for IgM at the airports in Kerala

- 1. Passengers should be given priority for IgM Antibody testing to following categories by having an independent counter.
 - a Pregnant women, Postnatal women with neonates
 - b Children less than 10 yrs
 - c Challenged passengers and differently able passengers
 - d Passengers with severe comorbidity
 - e Elderly
 - f Family members accompanying any of the above mentioned passengers
- 2. All symptomatic people arriving at airport need to be isolated to COVID hospital/ CFLTC irrespective of antibody test results.
- 3. All those tested negatives for IgM shall be sent to home for strict quarantine as per existing protocol following 'sanitised corridor'
- 4. All those who found positive for IgM antibody need to be shifted to COVID Care Centres with individual rooms and attached bathrooms.
- 5. Nasopharyngel swab need to be collected from those tested positive for IgM and sent to laboratory for RTPCR test as follows. Priority samples (Samples of pregnant women, postnatal, children < 10yrs, handicapped, elderly may be tested using Xpert/Trunat machines available at district for speedy decision making). Write in SRF as IgM positive.



6. Laboratory to which sample needed to be sent for confirmation

- 7. If the passengers found negative on RTPCR and if asymptomatic, they can be sent home for quarantine at home following protocol and 'sanitised corridor'
- 8. If found positive on RTPCR and symptomatic, they need to be isolated at COVID Hospital and if found positive on RTCPR and asymptomatic they need to be isolated at CFLTC based on existing protocol.
- 9. Sufficient HR to be ensured at all testing laboratories from NHM/HMC to run the tests for 24 hours.
- 10. Since these are samples of IgM positive individuals, pooling of samples should not be done.
- 11. Laboratories are also advised to fastrack the sample of expatriates and provide results at the earliest.
