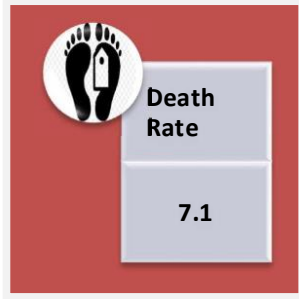

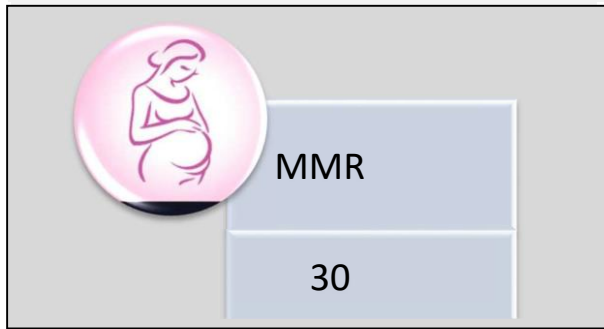

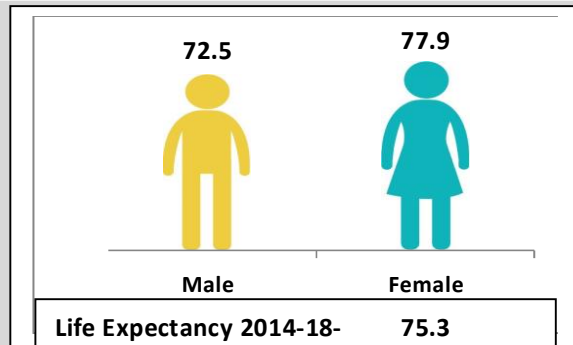
6. BIRTH RATE AND MORTALITY RATES (SRS 2019)



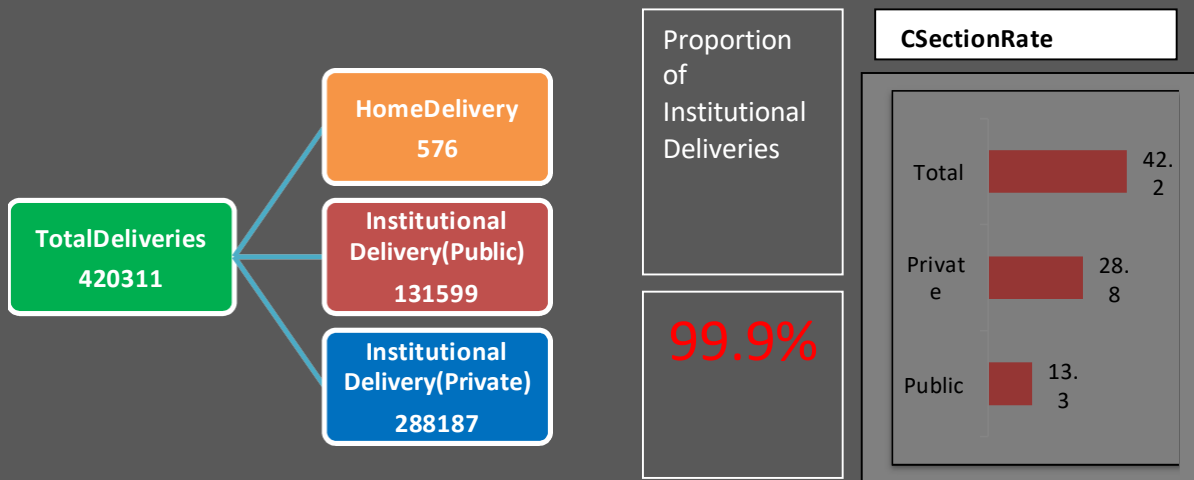
6.1 MATERNAL MORTALITY RATIO (MMR) SRS 2017-19



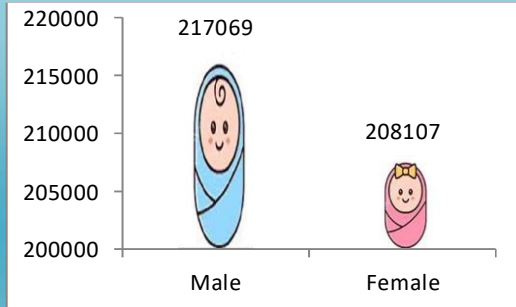

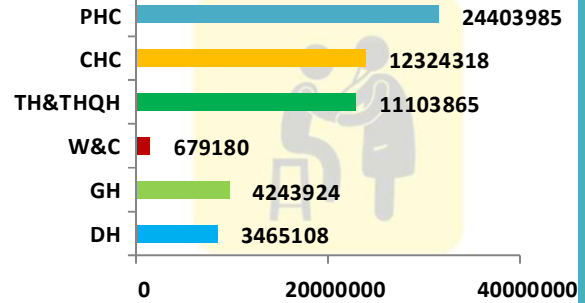

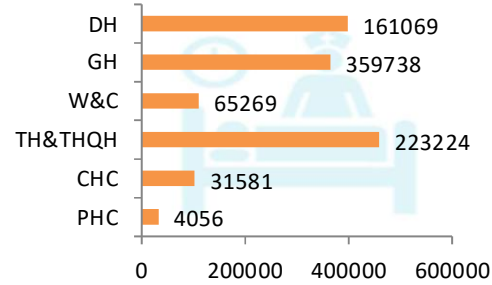

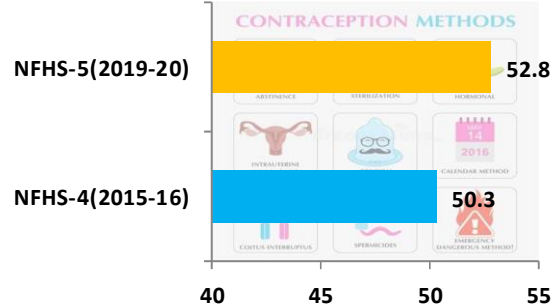
11. IPD BY TYPE OF FACILITY 2020-21 (HMIS)

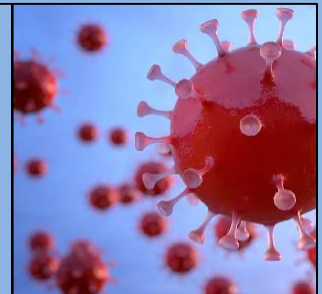

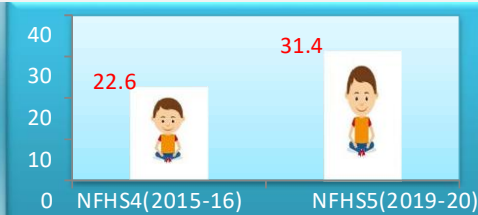

The first case of the COVID-19 pandemic in Kerala was confirmed in Thrissur on 30 January 2020.

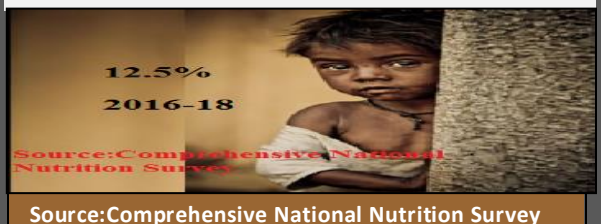

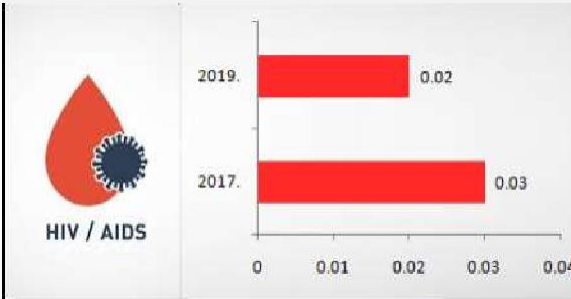
17. PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN AGED 1-4 YEARS HAVING ANAEMIA (ANY <11.0g/DL)



18. PERCENTAGE OF CHILDREN AGED 1-4 YEARS HAVING ANAEMIA (ANY <11.0g/DL)

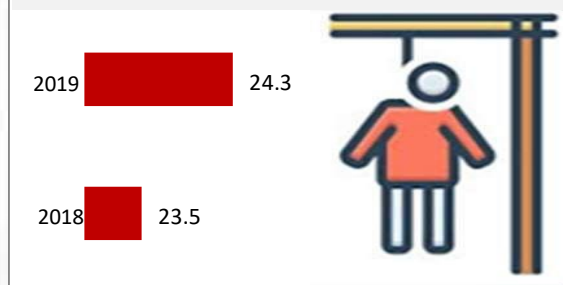


19.HIV INCIDENCE PER 1000 UNINFECTED POPULATION

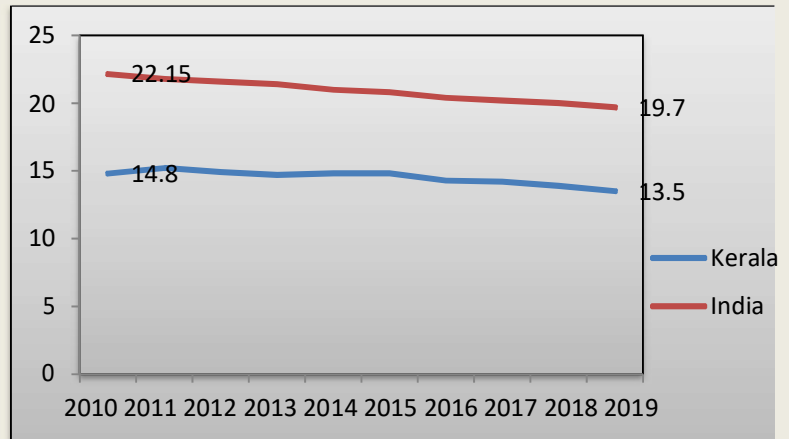

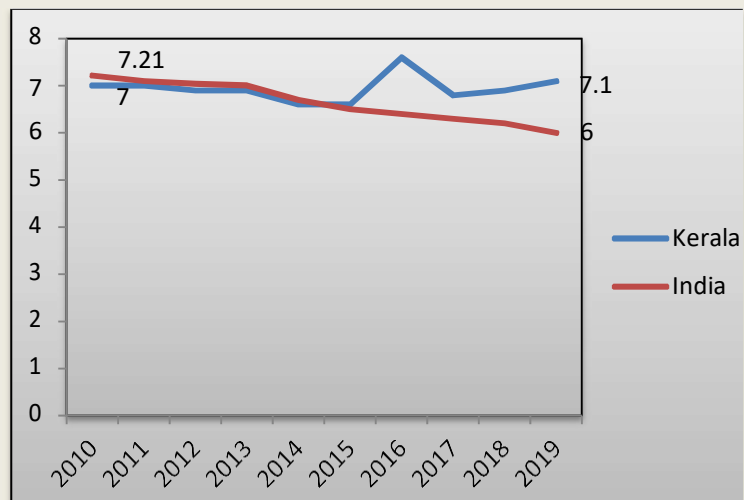

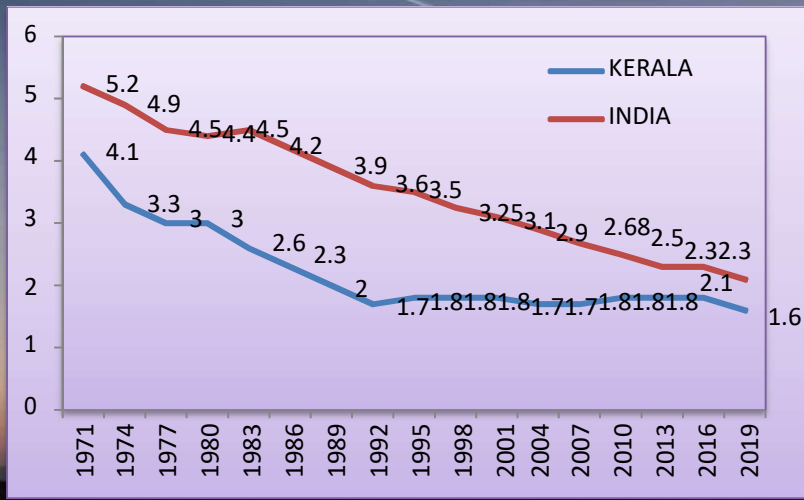

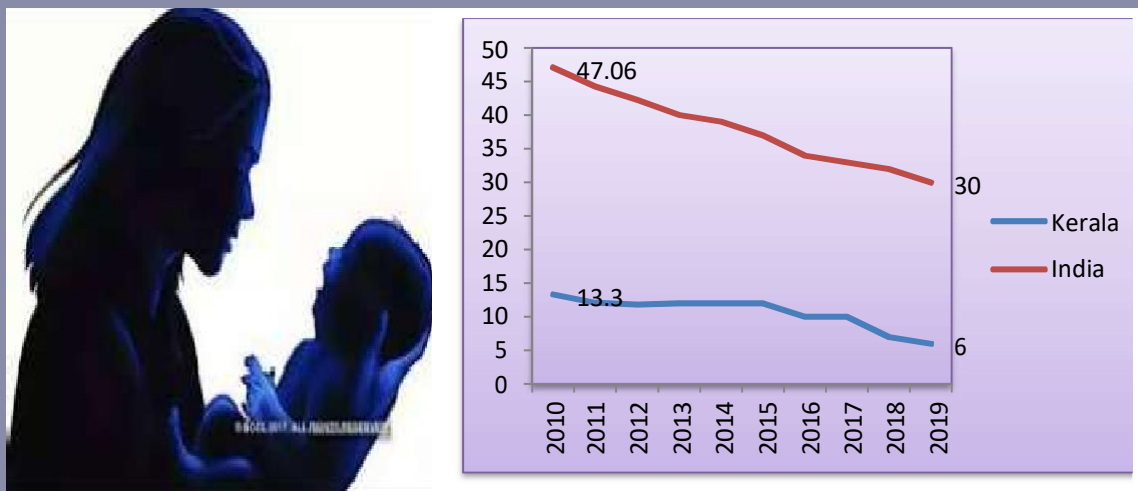

2.1.1.3 TOTAL FERTILITY RATE



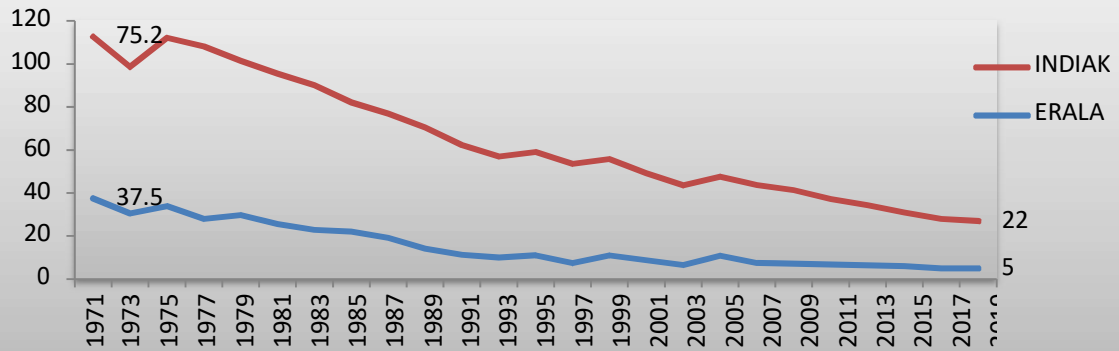

2.1.1.4 INFANT MORTALITY RATE



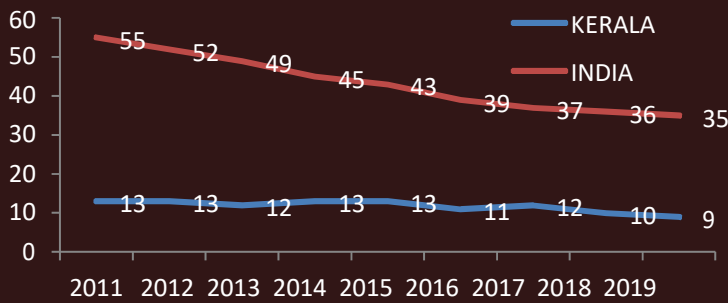

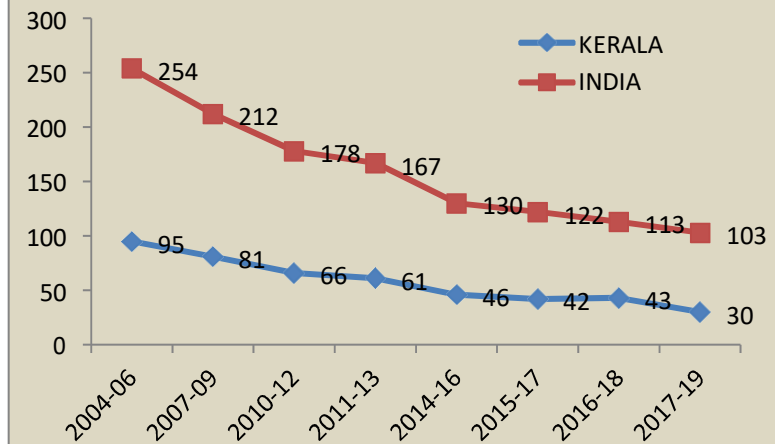

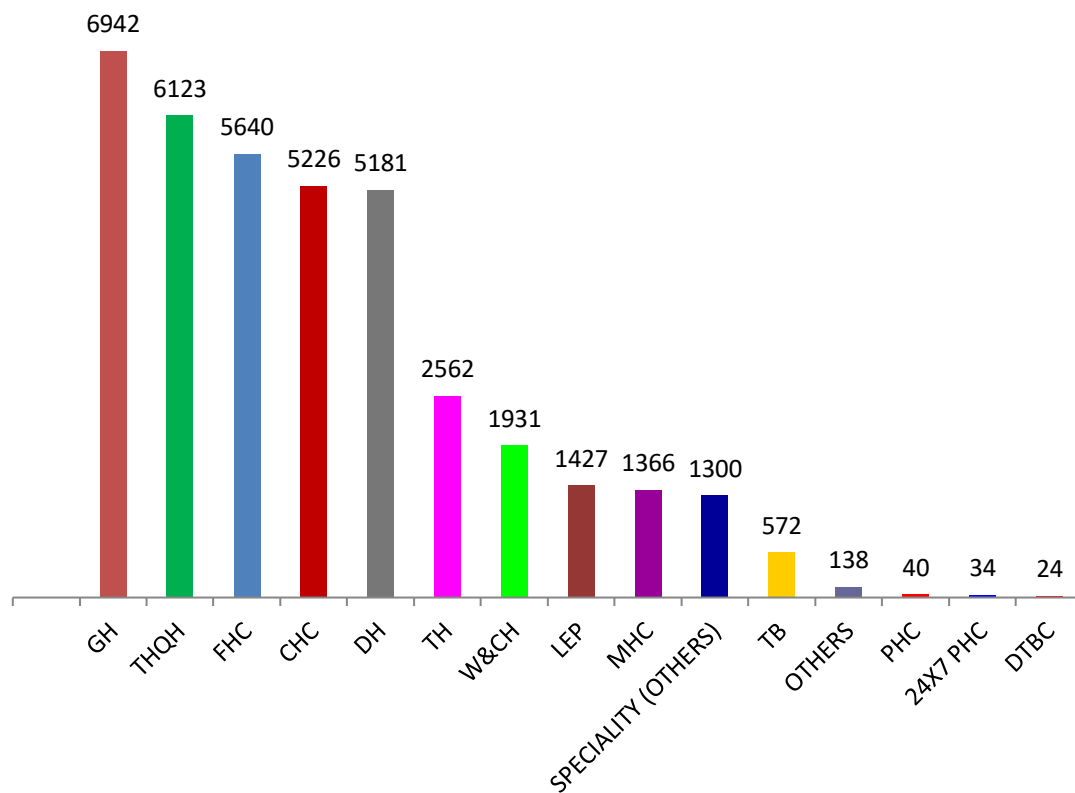

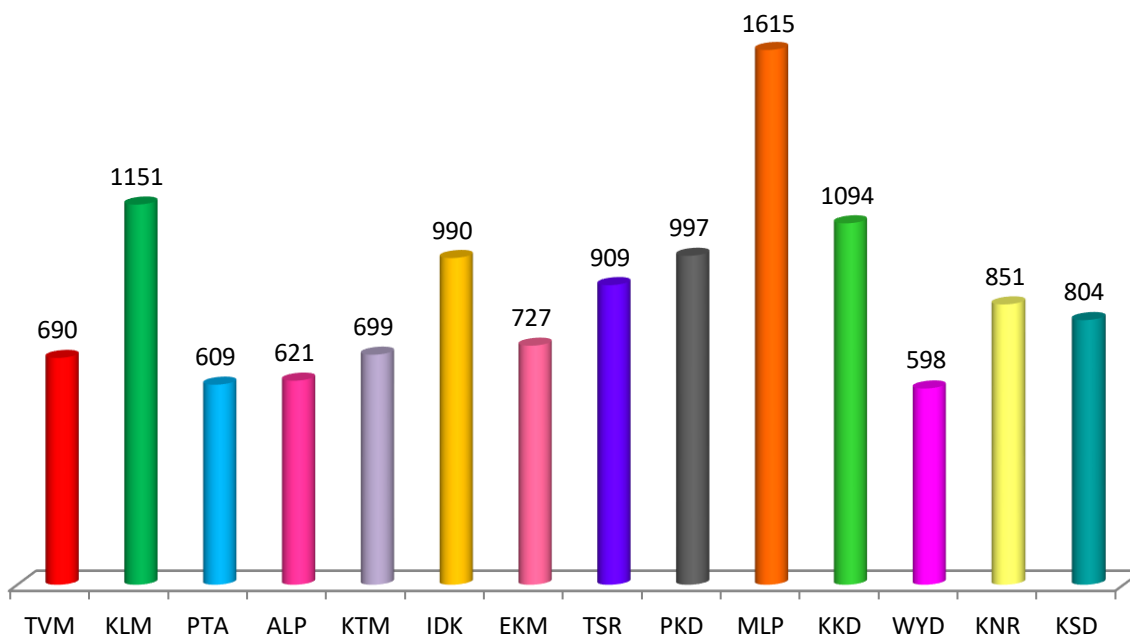

Chart 3.3.1 Percentage of increase in OP and IP in the institutions under DHS and NHM from 2019-20 to 2020-21

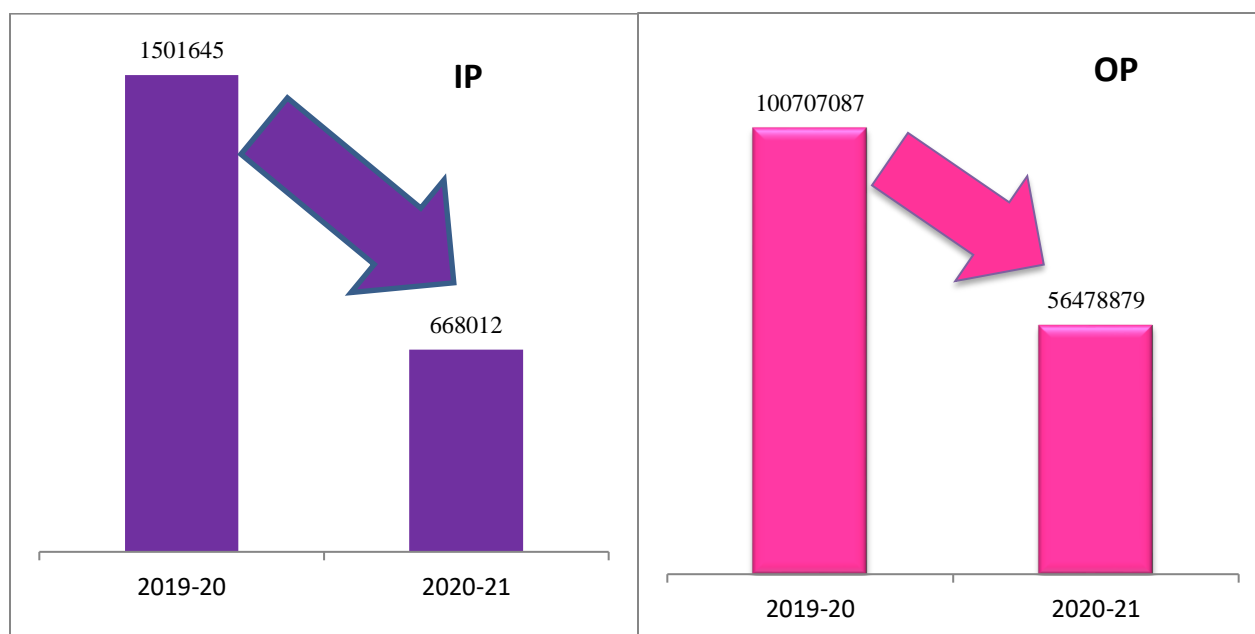
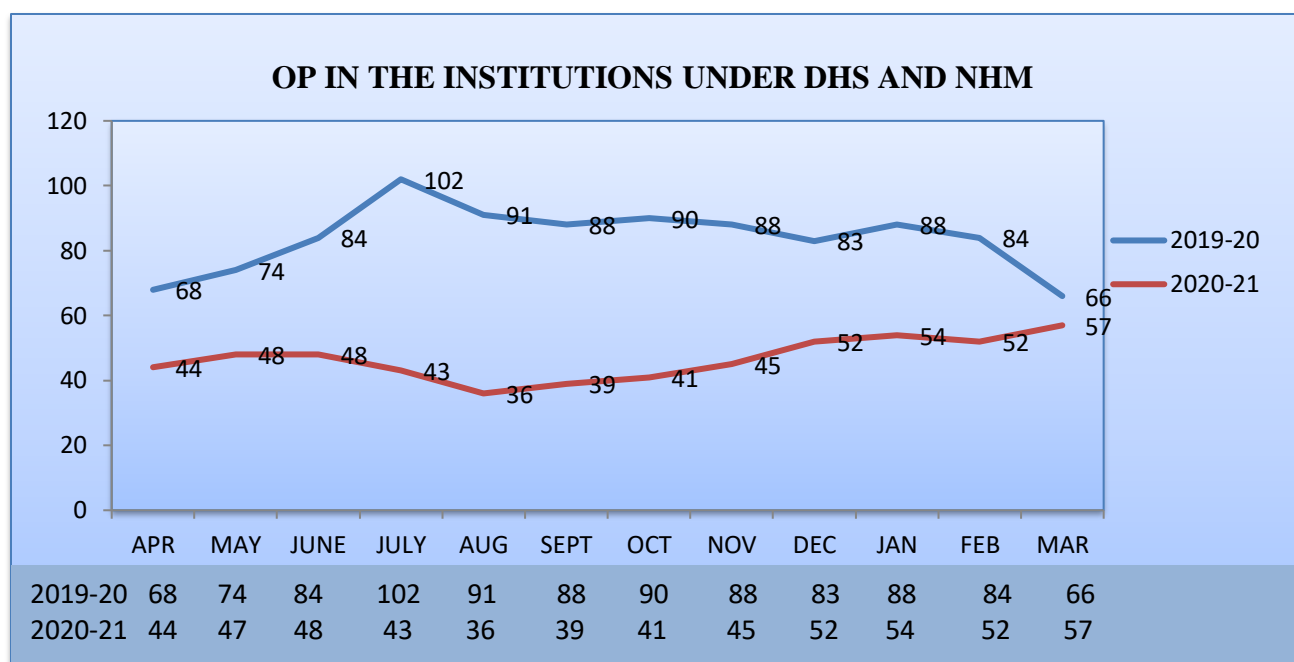


Chart 3.3.2 Month wise comparison of OP in the institutions under DHS and NHM

Chart 3.4.4.1 Full Immunization coverage in Kerala 2020-21 (Children born on 2019-20)

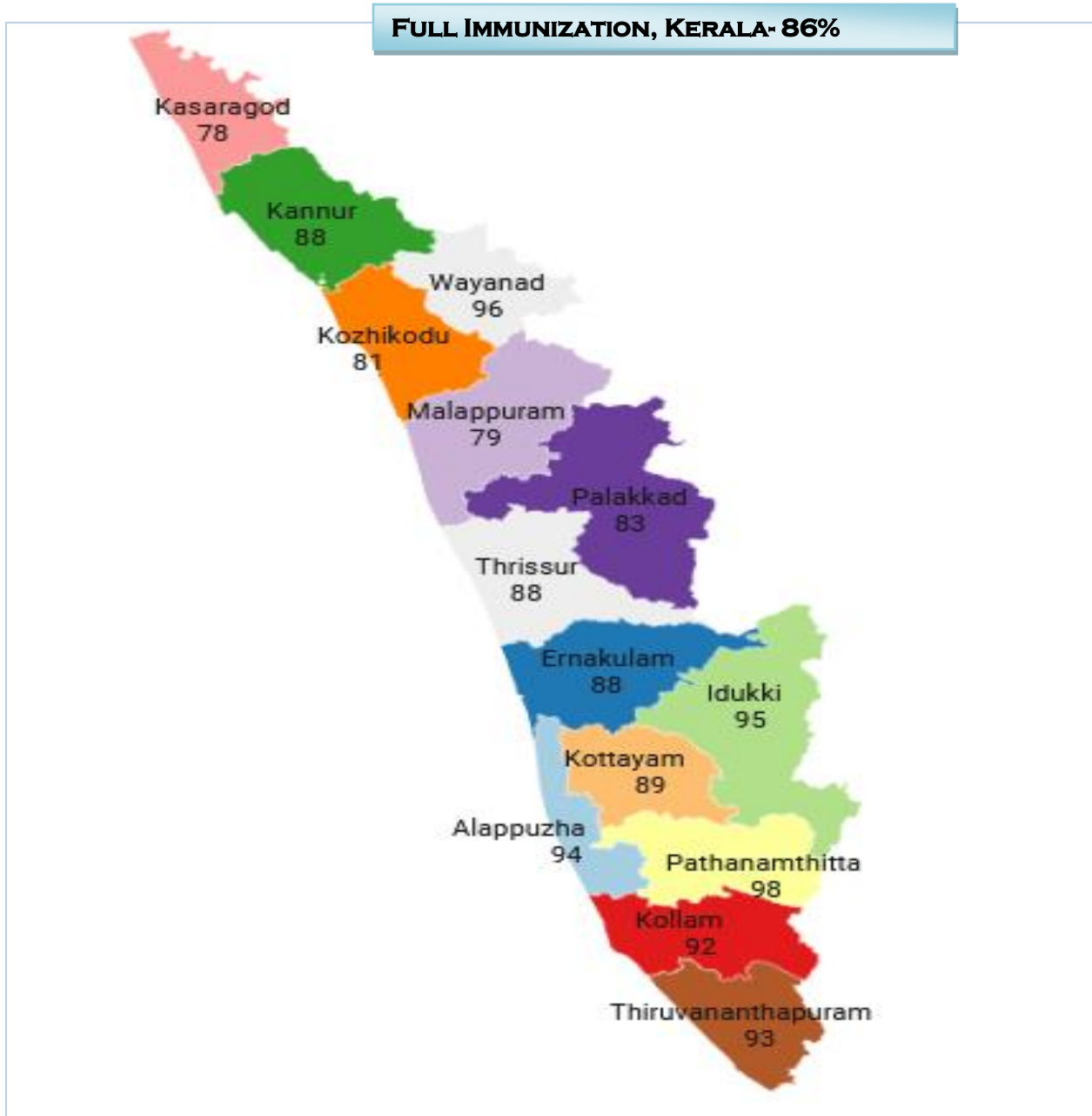

Chart 3.4.4.1 Immunization coverage in Kerala 2020-21 (Children born in 2019-20)

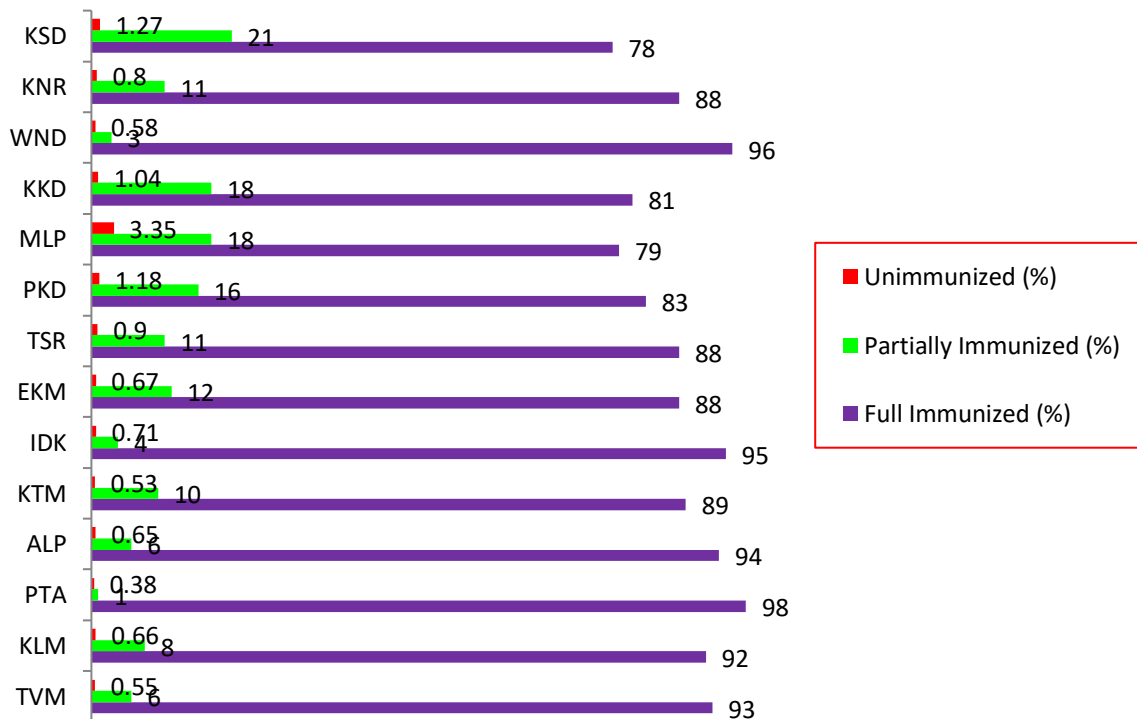

Chart 3.4.4.1.1 Intensified Pulse Polio Immunization Program 2021-District wise Achievement (%)

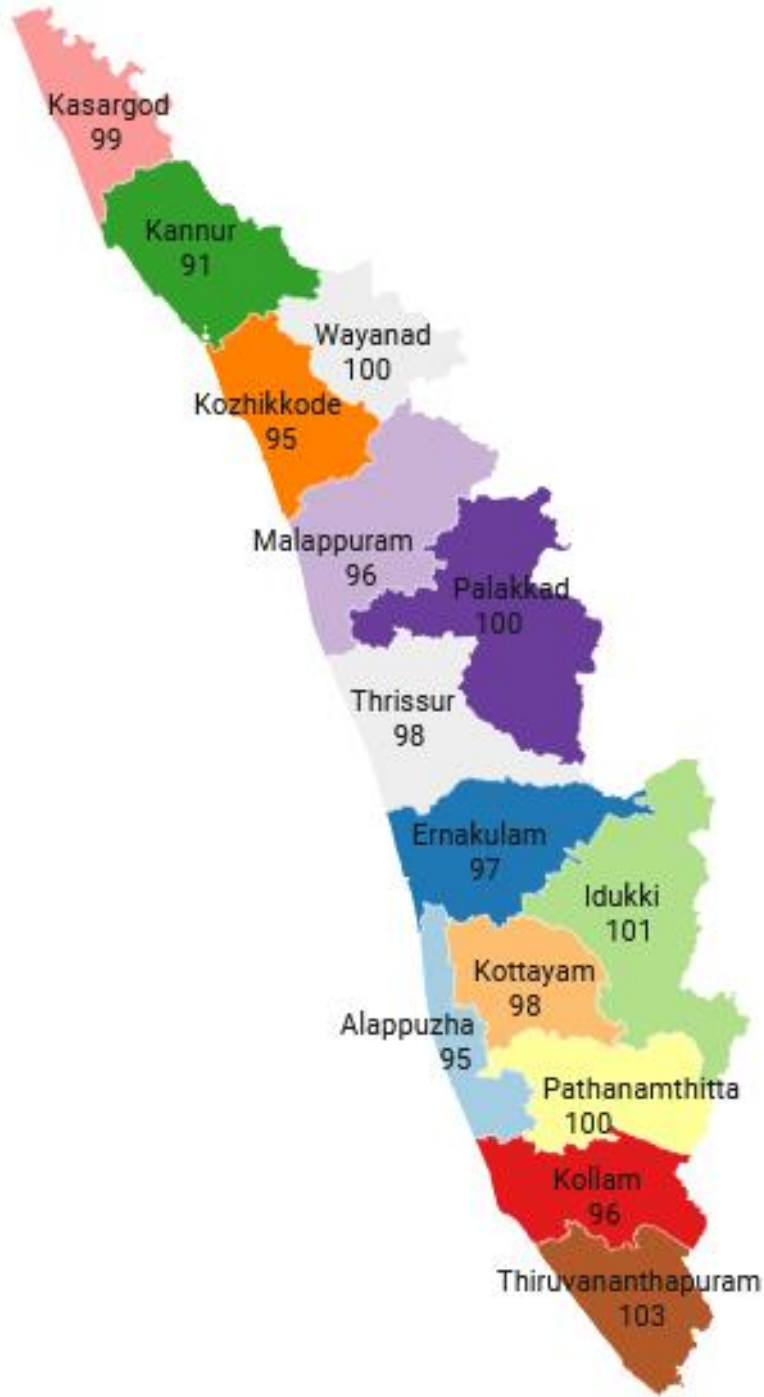

3.4.4.2 INTENSIFIED MISSION INDRADHANUSH 3.0

About the Programme

The Government of India is committed to improve immunization coverage and achieve full immunization coverage of 90 percent. Launch of massive routine immunization campaigns, such as Mission Indradhanush (MI) and Intensified Mission Indradhanush (IMI), in part, reflects government's efforts under Universal Immunization Program to reduce child mortality and morbidity. Government introduced Intensified Mission Indradhanush 3.0 to boost the RI coverage in the country to ensure to reach the unreached with all available vaccines and accelerate the coverage of children and pregnant women in the identified districts and blocks from December 2019-March 2020. An IMI 3.0 Portal was designed to manage the data reporting and analysis, and to update the activities of the ministries/departments and to capture pre-campaign activities, during activity achievements, and post campaign indicators with indicators on immunization coverage and of the line ministries.

Achievement

In Kerala, the programme was conducted in Kannur, Kollam, Malappuram, Palakkad and Trivandrum districts. In I round of IMI 3.0 held on February 2021, 37% of target pregnant women population were immunized and 23% of children population were immunized. In II round of IMI 3.0 held on March 2021, 31% of target pregnant women population were immunized and 13% of children population were immunized.

Chart 3.5.1.1 District wise Maternal Mortality Ratio (MMR) 2020-21

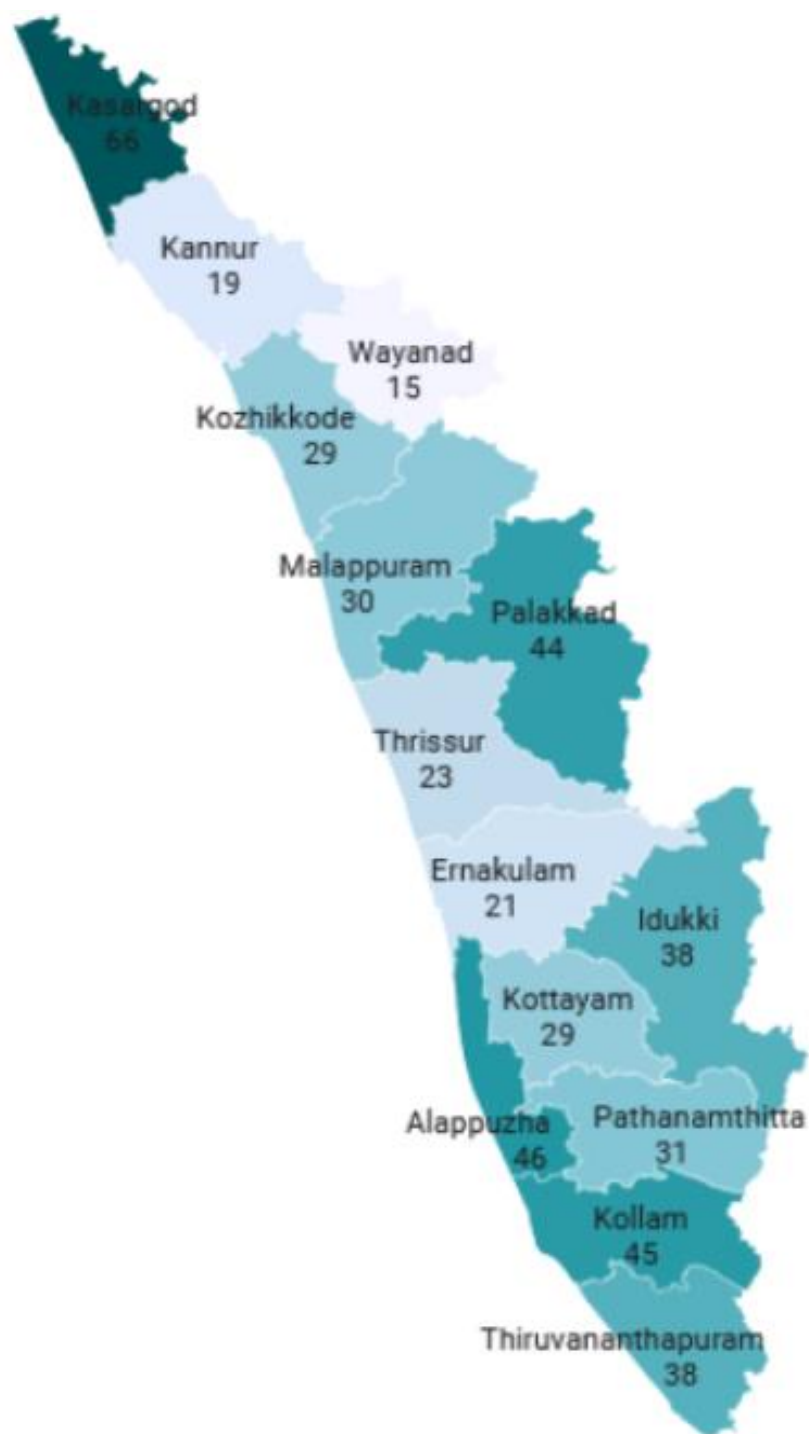

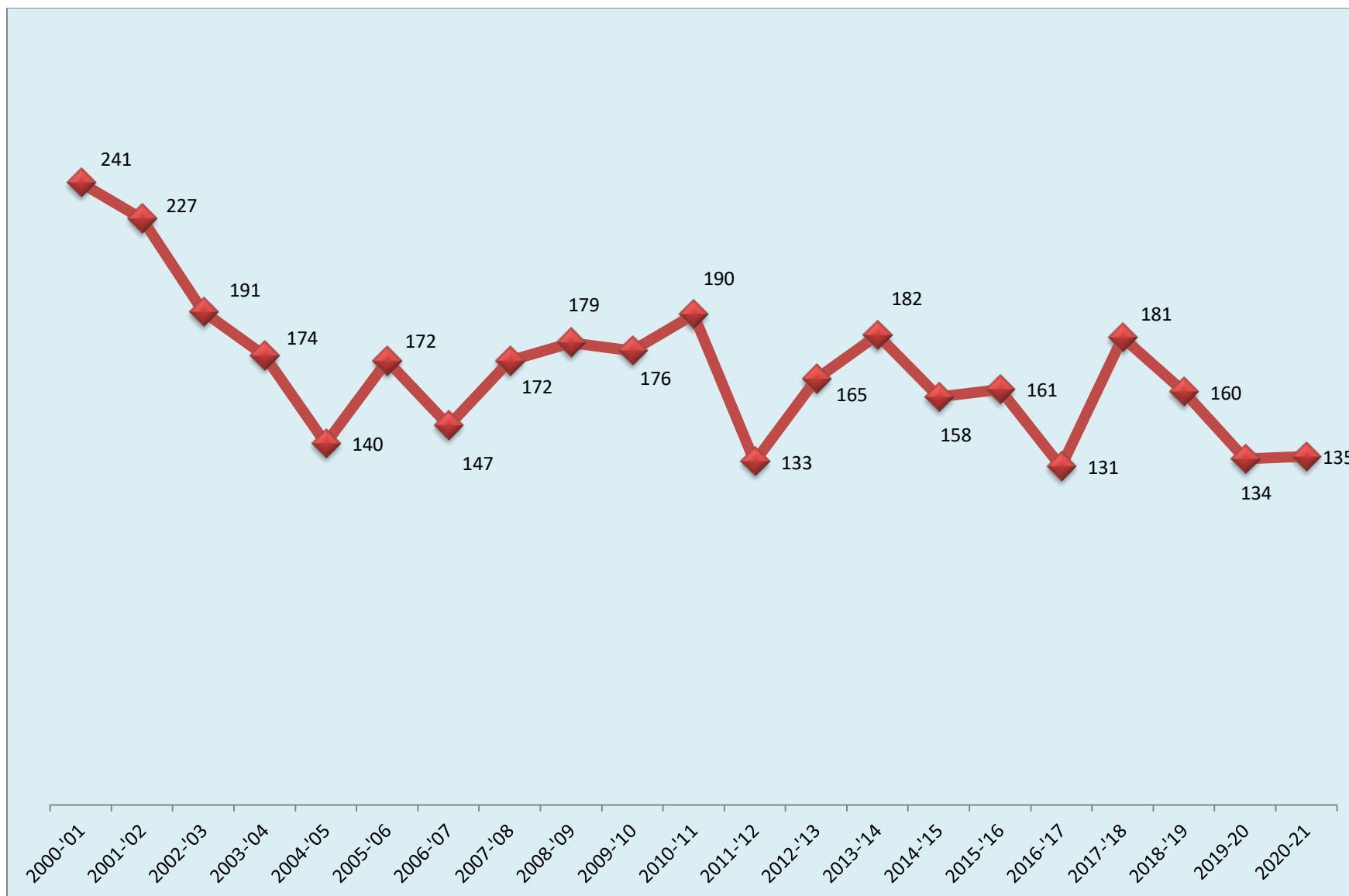

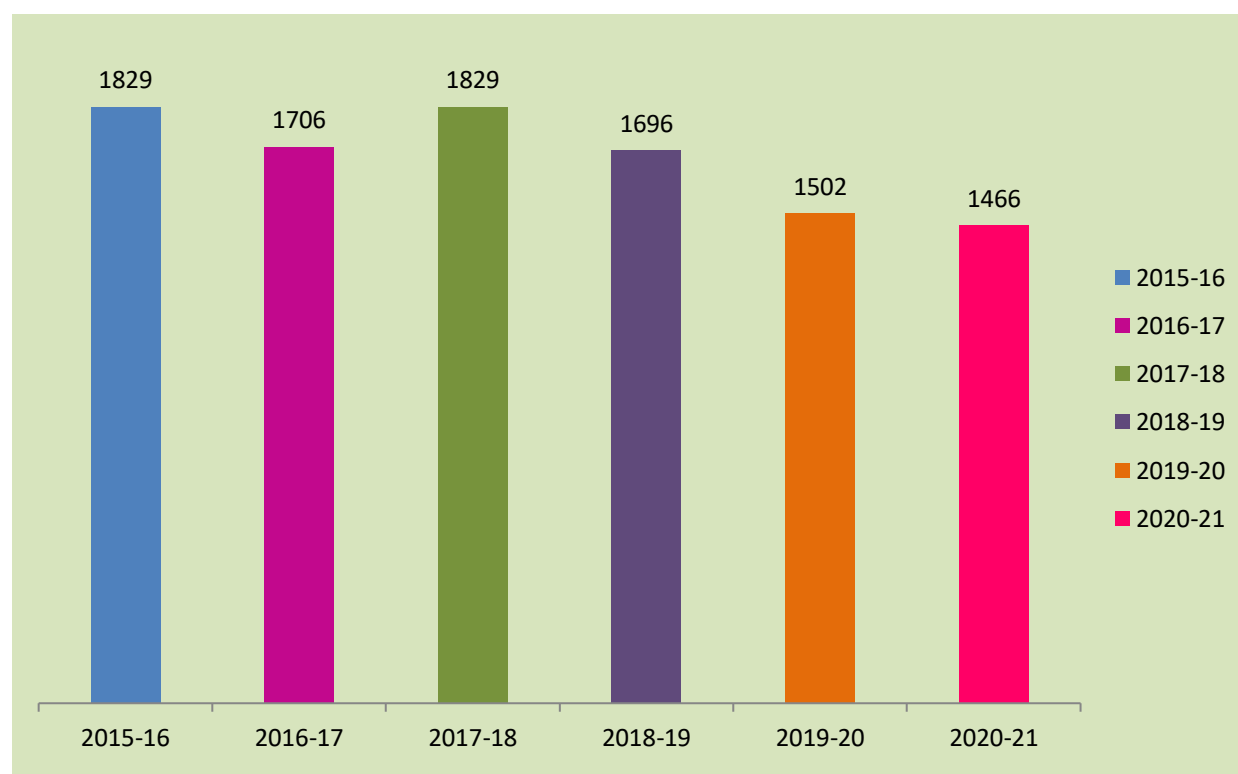

Chart 3.5.3.1 District Wise Infant Mortality Rate (IMR) 2020-21

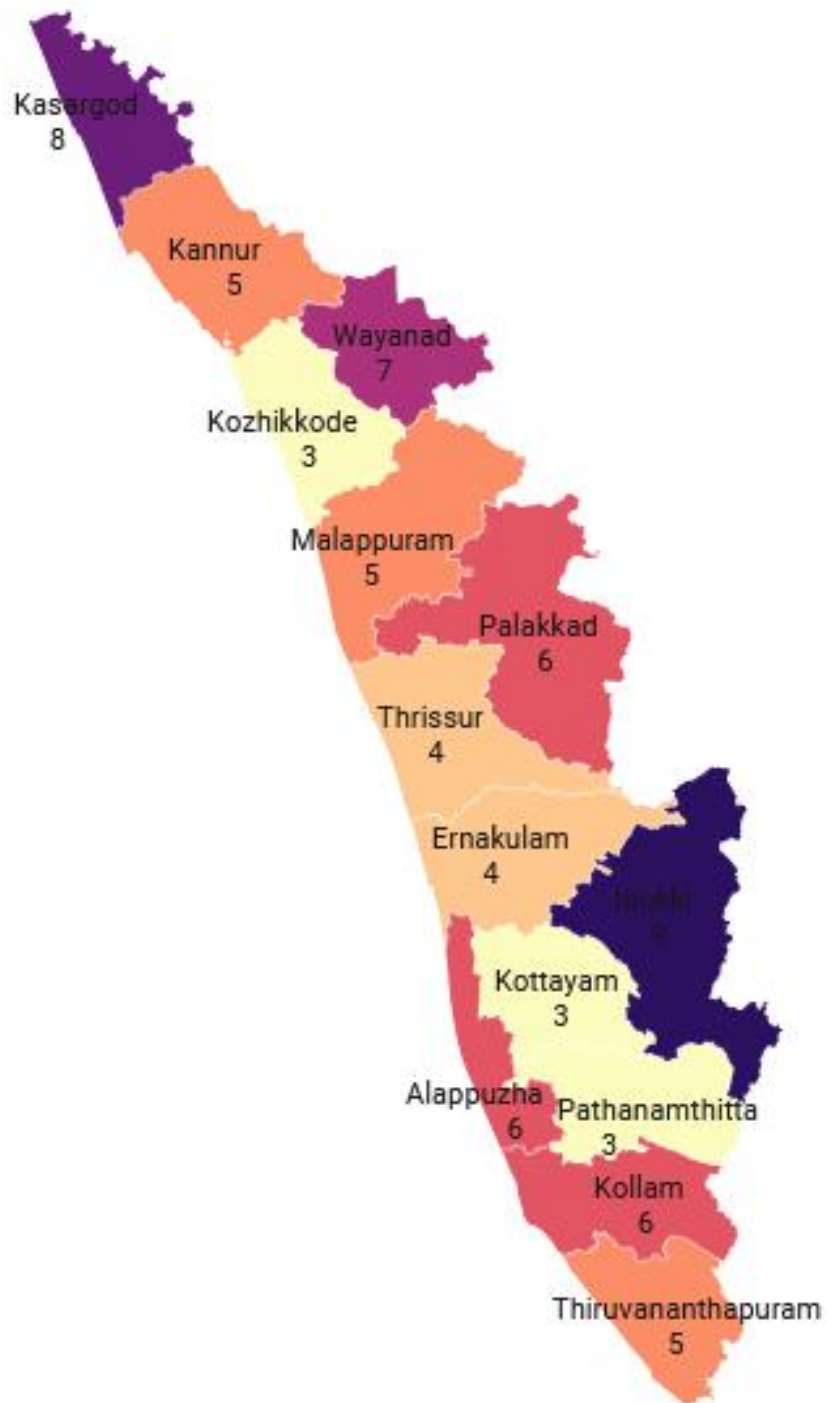

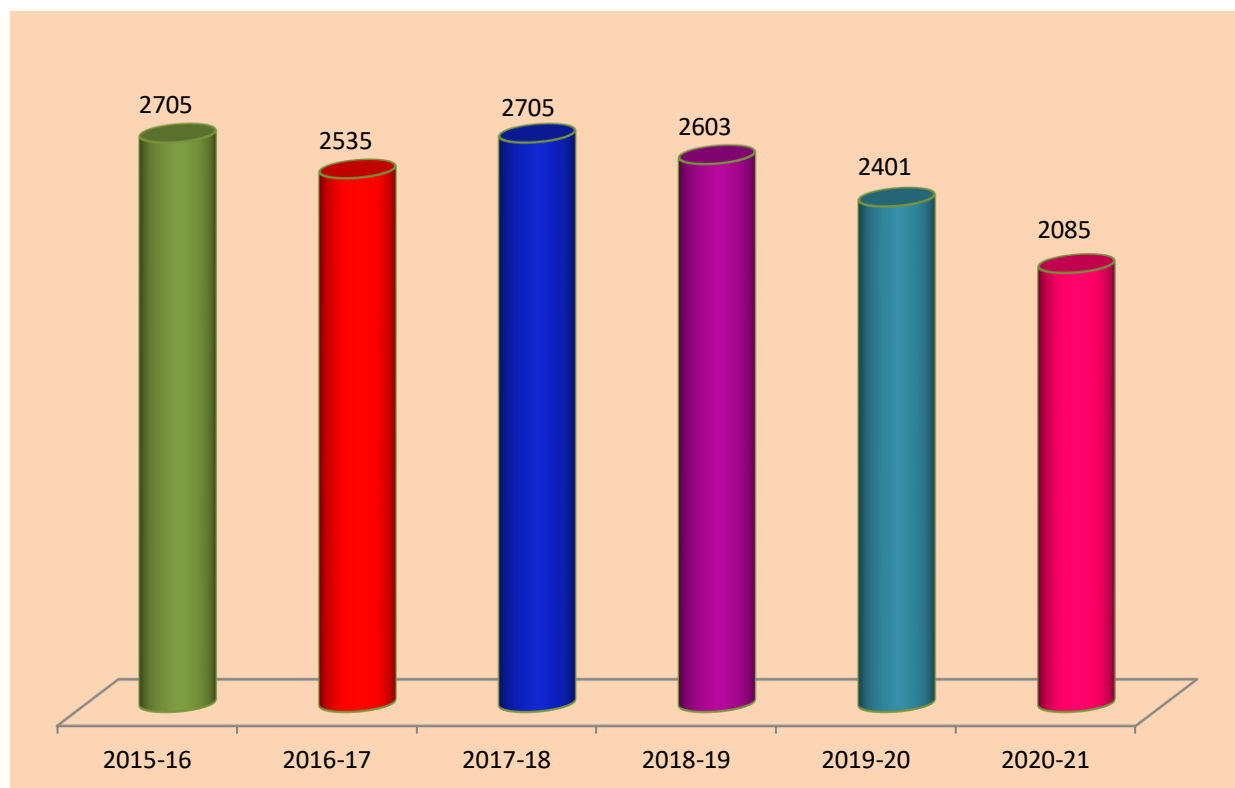

Chart 3.5.3.3 Year wise comparison of Infants deaths and IMR in Kerala



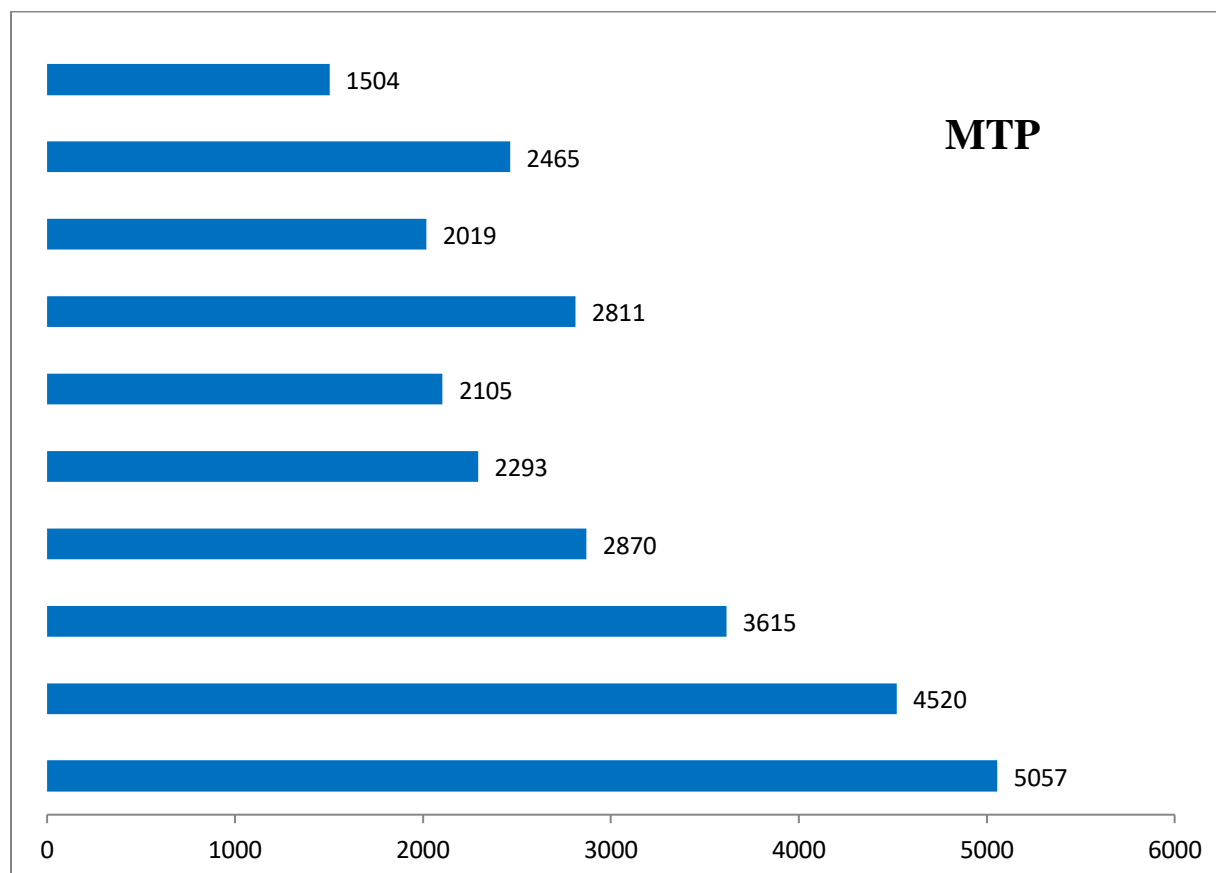

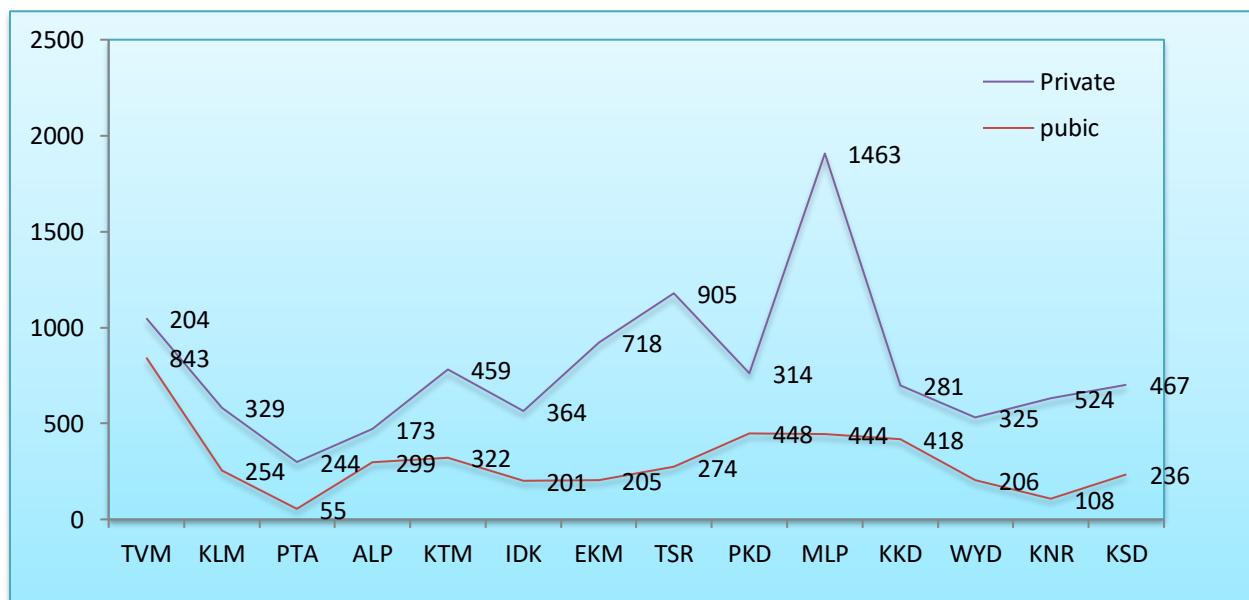
Chart 3.6.1 Year wise medical Termination of Pregnancy in the Public Hospitals in Kerala
