ORDER

The Hon'ble High Court in the Judgment read as 1st paper above had upheld the provisions contained in Clause 4.4.1 of the Prospectus for admission to Post Graduate Medical courses for the year 2014. Accordingly the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations had conducted counseling to the Service Quota seats on 22nd and 23rd of June 2014, subject to the condition that the admission given to the Service Quota candidates are provisional and subject to the final orders in WA No.797/2014 and connected cases.

2. The Hon'ble Division Bench of the High Court has set aside the Clause 4.4.1 of the Prospectus and allowed the Writ Appeals vide Judgment read as 3rd paper above. The Commissioner for Entrance Examinations has now requested to issue orders in the light of the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court.

3. Government have examined the case in detail. The last date for closing admissions to Medical P.G courses for the year 2014 as fixed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India is 10th July 2014. The process of finalizing the rank list, selection, allotment and admission have to be completed before the stipulated time. In the

circumstances the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations is authorized to conduct re-counseling to the Service Quota candidates as per the eligibility criteria stipulated by the National Board of Examinations (NBE) for AIPGMEE-2014; ie, 50% of marks for General Merit candidates, 40% for SC/ST/SEBC candidates and 45% for PD candidates, after obtaining the revised seniority list from the Head of the Departments concerned. The counseling to the Service quota shall be done along with the counseling to vacant State Quota seats and unavailed All India Quota seats.

4. The Director of Medical Education, the Director of Health Services and the Director of Insurance Medical Services will publish the revised seniority list of the eligible Service Quota candidates of the respective departments and furnish the same to the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations forthwith for further counselling/allotment.


