HEALTH EDUCATION PROGRAMME At SRI CHITRA HOME, Typm.-A Report

Diploma in Health Inspector Course students of Public Health Training School(PHTS), Tvpm . organized a health education programme at Sri Chitra Home, Tvpm. under the leadership of Principal and faculty members of PHTS, Tvpm. The 2012-'14 Batch of students could visit Sri Chitra Home along with Communication Officer on 26/03/2013 out of social interest. Principal, PHTS and Superintendent, Sri Chitra Home facilitated the same.

During the last visit, the students realized the need for an intensive health education programme for the inmates of the home and this was the motivating factor for organizing a programme on 28/05/2014. Students made all arrangements in the auditorium of the Home on the previous day for conducting educational programme. Stage arrangements were made, posters designed by students on health promotion was exhibited, note books for donation was purchased, registration sheet, programme sheet and evaluation questionnaire were prepared.

Personal hygiene, Environmental Sanitation, Dry Day Observance, No Smoking, Nutrition etc. were the various topics selected for delivering health message through different communication methods.

An evaluation was also conducted in order to give a learning experience for students on assessing health programmes . A questionnaire was prepared. The same was administered before and after the programme. The evaluation was conducted with the co-operation of Management Instructor, PHTS. The programme ended with a group song with students of PHTS and the Home. The funds for the programme were mobilized as a united effort of the Principal, Faculty members and students.Ms. Nayana Mohanan delivered vote of thanks and programme came to a close at 1 P.M.
