This is to inform you the following for your information and urgent necessary action.

Interest Free Medical Advance is being given to the State Government Employees to meet the emergency expenditure for the treatment of his and family members who are undergoing treatment in government hospitals and other government approved private institutions. This advance is sanctioned on the basis of the expenditure certificate obtained from the treating doctors. Now a days the expenditure certificate obtained from your institution is seen issued by the Medical record librarian in which only the required amount for the treatment is mentioned. There is no remarks on the plan of treatment, name of surgery, Name of costly medicine and implants proposed to be used etc. This makes much difficulties to assess the eligibility and the amount to be sanctioned. Moreover lack of clarity in Certificates makes heavy delay in sanctioning he amount which results in the denial of assistance in time to the deserving employees.

In this circumstances, I request you to take necessary steps to issue the Anticipating expenditure Certificate for purpose of IFMA by the treating doctor only with all possible details viz.

- 1. The Plan of treatment.
- 2. Name of Surgery Proposed.
- 3. Name of Costly Medicines and implants proposed to be used.
- 4. And cost of treatment.

In this regard, I request to take control measures in the issuance of such expenditure certificates by the Medical record Librarian and other non medical members for the purpose of Interest Free Medical Advance to the State Government Employees. An early action is solicited.
