ORDER

The Medical Council of India has issued Letter of Permission for starting MD Courses in Radiodiagnosis, Radiotherapy and Anaesthesiology courses with annual intake of 2, 8 and 2 seats respectively at Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram. The Director, Regional Cancer Centre has proposed to allot 50% of seats from among those who qualified in the All India Quota and to allot 50% of seats from the State Quota with ₹ 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) as tuition fees and ₹ 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) as Caution Deposit.

Government have examined the case in detail and are pleased to accept the proposal from the Director, Regional Cancer Centre, Thiruvananthapuram and hereby direct the Commissioner for Entrance Examinations to conduct allotment to 50% of the total seats each in MD Courses in Radiodiagnosis, Radiotherapy and Anaesthesiology in Regional Cancer Centre. Among the 4 (four) seats available for allotment in Radiotherapy, 3 (three) seats shall be allotted from the General merit candidates who qualified in the NEET PG 2013 Entrance Examination for PG Medical Admission 2013. The remaining 1 (one) seat in Radiotherapy and 1 (one) seat each in Radiodiagnosis and Anaesthesiology shall be allotted from the eligible candidates under Service Quota. The Director, Regional Cancer Centre is also allowed to allot 50% seats from the rank list of the All India Quota.


The tuition fee for the courses for the General Merit candidates including the reservation categories will be ₹ 3,00,000/- (Rupees Three Lakh only) and the Caution Deposit will be ₹ 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand only). The candidates under Service Quota shall be governed by the existing regulations for admissions to Government Medical Colleges regarding tuition fee and other conditions.
