Sub:- Guidelines for "Family Planning Indemnity Scheme" Corrigendum regarding.

Dear Sir,

This is with reference to the Guidelines for "Family Planning Indemnity Scheme" sent to the State/UTs vide letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> February, 2013.

In the Guidelines, section on (Benefits) at page No.'3' marked 'Note' mentions that "Claims arising out of cases of sterilization operations conducted before 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2013, will not come under the purview of State Programme Implementation Plans(PIPs). Such claims would be covered as per the respective guidelines of expired policies from 29<sup>th</sup> November 2005 to 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2013".

Perhaps due to the above reason the States are continuing to send the claims pertaining to sterilization cases before 1<sup>st</sup> April 2013 to the Insurance Company.

It may be emphasized here that the Insurance Company's admissibility of claims is only for the cases detected and reported 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2013 and the last date for submission of such cases was upto 15<sup>th</sup> May, 2013. Hence, in view of the above the following changes have been brought about in the scheme.

Claims arising out of cases of sterilization operations conducted before 1 <sup>st</sup> April, 2013, will not come under the purview of State Programme Implementation Plans(PIPs). Such claims would be covered as per the respective guidelines of expired policies from 29 <sup>th</sup> November 2005 to 31 <sup>st</sup> March, 2013	Claims arising out of cases of sterilization operations which were detected and reported after 1 <sup>st</sup> April, 2013, will come under the purview of State Programme Implementation Plans(PIPs). Claims arising out of cases of sterilization operations detected and reported before 1 <sup>st</sup> April, 2013, will not come under the purview of State Programme Implementation Plans(PIPs). Such claims would be covered as per the respective guidelines of expired policies from 29 <sup>th</sup> November 2005 to 31 <sup>st</sup> March, 2013.
