ORDER No.EF2-76388/15/DHS,TVM, Dated 02/03/2017

The Honourable Administrative Tribunal by order shown in reference 1st has directed this respondent to recall the applicants in both OA No.1456 & 1697 of 2016 and to post them in the existing 17 vacancies of Lab Technician Gr.I. It was also directed that such process will be done as expeditiously as possible , at any rate, within a period of 10 days from the date of receipt of copy of this order. Simultaneously the eligibility of Lab Technician Gr.II who have to be promoted as Lab Technician grade I in 102 vacancies will also have to be worked out in order to maintain 1:1 ratio and such eligible persons will be promoted. Also that the Junior most out of the newly promoted Grade I officers as well as the existing juniors in Grade I now adjusted against Grade II posts in Thiruvananthapuram district will be transferred out for facilitating advice of eligible PSC candidates. The number of PSC hands will be worked out by maintaining 1:1 ratio in 146 posts, ie. 73:73. Such an exercise will be finalized within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

The second respondent will simultaneously communicate to the Public Service Commission about the number of vacancies in Grade II posts for advising the candidates included in the current rank list published by the PSC.

In compliance of the above order of the Honourable Administrative Tribunal as an initial steps the 17 applicants both OA No.1456 & 1697 of 2016 was allotted District Medical Officer (H), Thiruvananthapuram for suitable posting as per reference 3rd cited.

As per the direction of Honorable Kerala Administrative Tribunal in reference 1st cited this respondent is bound to promote 102 Junior most Lab Technician Gr.II in the cadre of Grade I within two weeks and the ratio of 1:1 ie. 73:73 among the Lab Technician Gr. I & II in Thiruvananthapuram District to be maintained. The excess Lab Technician Gr.I in Thiruvananthapuram District is to be transferred out to another district for reporting the excess vacancies occupied by Gr.I Lab Technicians.

Accordingly this respondent produced the list of senior most 102 Lab Technician Gr.II who are eligible for promotion to Lab Technician Gr.I, along with list of incumbents who will get promotion from Thiruvananthapuram District before the Honourable Tribunal.

As per the order shown in reference 2nd, the Honourable Tribunal directed this respondent to promote 102 candidates and transfer out 12 candidates from Thiruvananthapuram for accommodating PSC hand. The Honourable Tribunal was also given direction to PSC to advise 12 candidates to Thiruvananthapuram District. The below mentioned incumbents included in reference 4th cited, from Thiruvananthapuram district is transferred and allotted to other DMO(H) as mentioned below.
