**ORDER NO.EG2- 49581 /2016/DHS.TVPM DATED:24/10/2016**

The applicants while working as Junior Health inspector Grade-I in Alappuzha District were transferred to Malappuram as per this office order read 3 above based on the Judgment dated 20/10/2015 & 11/11/2015 in O.P (KAT) No.290/2015 by the Honourable High Court of Kerala .Aggrieved by this, they have appealed before this respondent as per Annexure A3 representations and also filed O.A.No. 1301/16, 1302/16, 1774/16 &1794/16 before the Honourable Tribunal for considering their representations. The Hon'ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal, in its orders read 1 above has directed to this respondent to take a decision on Annexure A3 representations after hearing the applicants and persons likely to be affected by any decision on Annexure A3.

In order to obey the direction of the Honourable Tribunal, this respondent heard the applicants and affected parties in person. The applicants were transferred based on the reports from the District medical Officer, Alappuzha dated 02.12.2015 read as 4<sup>th</sup> above. The applicants along with the 34 Junior Health Inspector Grades-I who had completed more than three years continuous service in Alappuzha District were transferred for considering the right of the seniors to get transfer to their native district. The main arguments in Annexure A3 representations are that the Junior Health Inspectors having more continuous service in Alappuzha District were retained overlooking the right of the applicants to continue there.

Necessary instructions was issued to the DMO(H), Alappuzha for furnishing detailed report in this matter and the same has been received vide letters read as 4<sup>th</sup> above dated 05.09.2016 and 06.10.2016. From the report it is seen that the following Junior Health Inspectors are continuously working in Alappuzha district from the date

of commencement of their service .The name of Sl.No. 3 to 10 were not included in the previous report dated 02.12.2015 and details against Sl.No.2 was incorrect.

Serial No.1 Sri. Rajeev Thomas, PHC Venmoney has produced the Disability Certificate of his unmarried brother Sri. Prakas Thomas who has congenital disability of Cerebral Palsy and completely bedridden and also that his father and mother are no more. His Guardianship Certificate of his brother is also produced. Considering the above facts Sri. Rajeev Thomas is retained in Alappuzha District on compassionate grounds.

A common issue raised by the affected parties at the time of hearing is that they have right to continue in Alappuzha District based GO(P)No.741/2016/II&FWD dated 02.03.2016 . The implementation of the said Government Order is stayed by the Hon`ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal as per orders read 2 above and the same is pending before the court.

As the anomalies raised in Annexure A3 representations submitted by the applicants is seen genuine, the following Junior Health Inspectors Gr.I are transferred and posted to the institutions / district noted against their name in compliance of the order from the Hon`ble Kerala Administrative Tribunal read 1 above.
