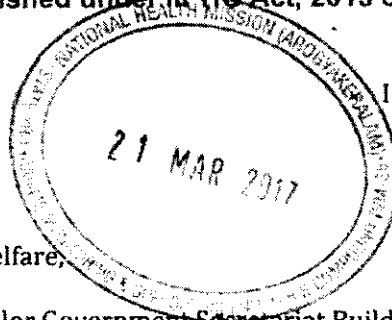

Dear *colleague,*

You are aware that the Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM) course conducted by PHFI is supported by Ministry Of Health and Family Welfare under the National Health Mission (NHM). The diploma course is a one year, full residential course aimed at capacity building of Mid-level health functionaries, so as to address the gap in the Public Health Managerial capacity amongst health professionals in the country with reputed partner Institutes.

2. The requirement of public health managers in our public health facilities is a felt need and hence after review of the program, the Ministry has decided to continue support for the course for the financial year 2017-18 @ Rs. 2.75 lakh for Government Institutions and Rs. 3.25 Lakhs for Private Institutions. The details of Institutes along with number of seats and a note on the utility of this course for health functionaries is attached as Annexure-I and II respectively.

3. I would earnestly request you to nominate eligible candidates for the said program directly to the partner institutes. The State/UT Governments are expected to treat the nominated officers as on duty. Nominated candidates have the flexibility to choose any of the partner Institutes and not merely the one assigned to the State. It is requested that wider publicity may be given to the program through website, direct e-mail to MBBS and AYUSH doctors and other health functionaries and through newspaper to attract suitable/adequate candidates.

4. The selection criteria for Government nominations in PGDPHM are as given below:

- a) Candidates working with central, state or local governments with at least three years of experience in health sector. Applicants should be MBBS/BDS/AYUSH graduates or should have passed B. Sc in nursing/health science/natural science or Bachelors of occupational therapy/ physiotherapy or MA in social sciences or an equivalent qualification.
- b) Nursing staff, municipal corporation officers and other professionals working in health related organisations may also be considered for nominations.
- c) Upper age limit may be kept as 50 years at the time of applying.

d) Willingness to serve in Public Health position after successful completion of the course. Candidates likely to be appointed as BMO/DPM/DHO/Dy.CMO/CMHO/ Civil surgeon should be given preference.

e) No other restriction should be imposed on the applicants except bond to serve in the Government after the course.

Note on importance of training in public health management for health functionaries working at Block, District and State levels under health system

The public health challenges being faced by respective States/ UTs in India call for capacity development at the levels of both, the State/ UTs and Central health systems. The need of the hour is therefore to position qualified professionals who can skilfully plan, execute and monitor national health policies and programmes, supervise the public health workforce, fully assess the dimensions of public health issues and devise appropriate strategies to meet emerging managerial challenges in the health system. It is well understood that for improved population health outcomes, the health officials occupying key positions at Block, District, and State levels should ideally have training in public health management. For effectively conducting National and State health programs, there is a felt need to develop public health managerial capacities among mid level health functionaries in sub cadres such as doctors, nurses, allied health professionals, etc. To address the gap of trained human resource in health systems, in addition to their clinical role, there is requirement to provide appropriate training to these health functionaries towards an administrative and managerial role. The grass root frontline field workers receive appropriate in-service training to supplement their pre-service qualifications. But in the case of mid level health functionaries, such capacity building opportunities in public health are minimal, though they are expected to supervise public health functions of frontline field workers.

It is ascertained that for a substantial public health management capacity enhancement within a short time, State Governments/ UTs need to offer a viable option, which would enable them to train large numbers of in-service health functionaries. In this regard, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India under National Health Mission (NHM) is sponsoring health functionaries across States/ UTs, to attend one year residential Post Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management (PGDPHM), since 2008. The fee of participants nominated by the respective state governments/ UTs for the course is being supported by NHM.

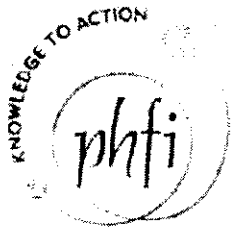
PGDPHM has been specifically developed in alignment with the stated objectives, strategies, and activities of NHM (earlier NRHM) for the training of these mid level health functionaries working in the states/ UTs to efficiently manage public health programme under health systems. The trained public health managers are able to oversee a range of functions ranging from community based disease surveillance, problem solving applications of epidemiologic principles and; participation in programme planning, implementation, monitoring & evaluation, supportive supervision, etc. This capacity generation is critical at all levels of the health system to meet the SDG targets based on primary health care approach.

The PGDPHM program is being conducted by Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) and other consortium partner institutions including the All India Institute of Hygiene and Public

Health (AIHH&PH) - Kolkata, IIPHs at Gandhinagar, Delhi, Hyderabad, Bhubaneswar, NIIIPW - New Delhi, JIPMER - Puducherry, PGIMER - Chandigarh, MGHMS - Wardha and (PHI) - Bangalore campus. Some of the state governments have also recognised this P. G. Diploma for promotions on public health positions.

So far, eight batches of PGDPHM participants have already completed the program and have joined their respective states. The States/ UTs have been requested to utilize these health functionaries in Public Health related positions at Block, District and State levels to deal with mainly - planning, program management, monitoring & evaluation, supportive supervision, quality assessment, etc. To ensure this, it is desirable that key positions of officials in managerial and administrative role such as Program Officers at Block, District, Divisional/ Regional and State level are occupied by the health functionaries with Degree/ PG Diploma in Public Health Management.

There is also need to consider various ways of incentivizing and encouraging more and more health functionaries to acquire public health degree/ diploma. The objective is to create a system where adequate incentive is available for doctors and other health functionaries with public health background to occupy key health program positions and add value to the program implementation. There is a need to build the capacities of more number of health professionals in public health to go on a long way in accelerating improvement in public health outcomes.

POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN PUBLIC HEALTH MANAGEMENT

BACKGROUND

The Public Health Foundation of India (PHFI) is pleased to announce its call for applications, for the ninth consecutive year, for the Post-Graduate Diploma in Public Health Management being conducted in the academic year August 2016 - July 2017, at the Indian Institutes of Public Health, Bhubaneswar (Odisha), Delhi NCR, Gandhinagar (Gujarat) & Hyderabad (Telangana).

The public health challenges being faced by the country calls for the development of capacity in the health systems of both the Central and State Governments by way of positioning qualified and skilled professionals who can execute and monitor national health policies and programs, supervise the public health workforce, fully assess the dimensions of public health issues and devise appropriate strategies to meet emerging challenges. The standard MBBS, MD (PSM) and DPH programs offered at medical colleges or the MBA, PG Diploma program offered at business schools do not significantly impart these managerial skills and competencies. Hence, this program is designed to impart the knowledge and skills to address and resolve key health management challenges.

OBJECTIVES

To enhance the capacity of the public health managerial workforce through the conduct and delivery of a specially designed post graduate diploma course in Public Health Management.

COURSE DURATION

The program would be a regular course lasting for nine months of class room teaching and three months of project work including field study. The total duration of the course is twelve months.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants should have a graduate/postgraduate degree in medicine, AYUSH, dental, nursing, pharmacy, health sciences, physiotherapy, occupational therapy, natural/life sciences, management, social sciences, social work, economics, statistics or any equivalent qualification.

Candidates with work experience in health/ development sector will be given preference.

Candidates from across India and from other countries can state their preference of the institute (Delhi NCR, Gandhinagar, Hyderabad & Bhubaneswar) in the application form.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection will be made strictly on the basis of merit. Eligible candidates would be screened, based on their application and statement of purpose by a specially constituted screening committee. Short-listed candidates would then be interviewed and the final list will be announced. The final selection of the candidate is based on qualifications, relevant experience, statement of purpose and

interview. The weightage for each component will be as follows:

Qualifications	30%
Relevant experience	30%
Statement of purpose	10%
Interview	30%
Total	100%

Decisions taken by the selection committee will be final.

COURSE FOCUS & TEACHING METHODS

This program is interdisciplinary both in its content and teaching. It utilizes a variety of teaching/ learning techniques, including seminars, journal clubs, collaborative learning, group discussions, case studies, lecture discussions, assignments, hands-on training on computers, visits to organizations of public health interest, practicum and field projects. Faculty with diverse disciplinary backgrounds, national and international experience combined with a breadth and depth of public health experience would be teaching this course.

PROJECT WORK

Each candidate working under close guidance of a faculty advisor, will develop and work on a project. Each candidate will be evaluated concurrently on the study protocol, while the study is in progress and terminally on his/her report.

COURSE FEES

The fee structure for PGDPHM for self-sponsored candidates in the year 2016-17 will be as follows:

For Indian Nationals:

1. Tuition Fee

The annual tuition fee for the academic year 2016-17 is Rs. 1.38 Lakhs per student. Additional scholarships for the tuition fee may be available.

2. Hostel Fee*

The hostel fee per student will be Rs. 1.38 Lakhs for one year program (Hostel fee covers accommodation and food). Hostel facility is optional.

For International Candidates:

1. Tuition Fee

The annual tuition fee for the academic year 2016-17 is 5,060 USD per student.

2. Hostel Fee*

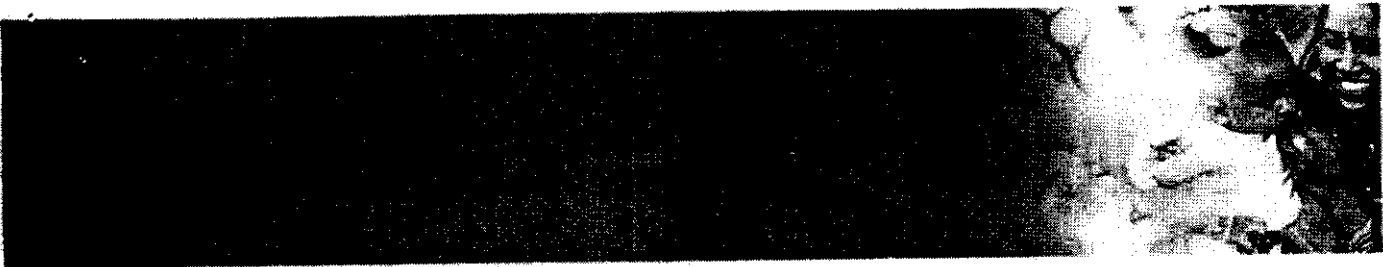
