

PROCEEDINGS OF THE ADDITIONAL DIRECTOR OF HEALTH SERVICES (A&T) DIRECTORATE OF HEALTH SERVICES, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM.

ORDER NO. EE4-6552/17/DHS/DATED: 05 /07/18

1. As per the order read 4th the State/District wise strength fixation between Pharmacist Gr.II and Gr.I in the ratio of 1:1 was ordered considering the number of posts existed on 31/12/2017. Accordingly in view of the existing sanctioned strength in both cadres, promotion can be made to the cadre of Pharmacist Gr.I, considering the present disparity between the posts of Pharmacist Gr.II and Gr.I with respect to the fixed strength.
2. As per the letter read as 6th paper above the present whereabouts of Pharmacists whose rank number between 374 and 550 in the seniority list of Pharmacist Gr.II for the period from 1999-2008 vide order read as 1st and 2nd paper above, have been called for to effect promotion to the cadre of Pharmacist Gr.I. details of whereabouts received have been verified.

3. In the above circumstances the Pharmacist Gr.II whose names are given in the Annexure I appended to this order are promoted to the cadre of Pharmacist Gr.I on 26500-56700 under Rule 31 (a) (i) of KS&SSR with effect from the date of this order. The name of incumbents who are excluded from the previous promotion order vide 3rd above are also included in Annexure I.

4. The incumbents are allowed to continue in the present district consequent on promotion and institution wise change with in the district can be made by concerned District Medical Officers (Health) if required.

5. The promotes are bound to work in any of the institutions across the State since the post of Pharmacist Gr.I is in the state wise cadre. No special preferential claim will be given to the Pharmacist Gr.I employees for transfer to other districts/stations. If any of the promotees comes under the purview of Inter District/Inter Departmental Transfer, their future seniority will be governed in the provisions in Government orders 7th,8th,9th read above.

6. Before permitting the promotees to join in the higher post (Pharmacist Gr.I) the Head of office should confirm their rank Number, Name, Date of birth, District/Present Station. If any employee is promoted in this order due to faulty whereabouts furnished by the DMO(H) and who are not in service now (LWA, Long Level Supervision etc) or any of them has already been promoted as Pharmacist Gr.I vide Order read 3rd above, such employees will automatically be deleted from annexure I of this order. The details of such incumbents should be forwarded to this office immediately by DMO(H) concerned.

7. All the District Medical Officers (Health) are directed observe the 1:1 ratio between Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in their districts concerned. Any disparity in this regard should be reported to this office at the earliest. In future the ratio between Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II in district level should be strictly maintained as 1:1.
8. The promotes are directed to submit 3 copies of joining report in the proforma I appended to this order to the Heads of Office concerned. After making necessary entries in their service Books, the Heads of Office should forward two copies of joining report to DMO(H) concerned and DMO(H) should forward a copy of joining report to DHS along with the counter signature for confirming their promotions in the cadre of Pharmacist Gr.I. All the DMO(H)/Heads Office should maintain separate cadre registers of Pharmacist Gr.I and Gr.II(on the basis of the joining report of the promotes in the higher cadre (Pharmacist Gr.I).

The following employees are excluded from the promotion order.

- a. Those employees who have opted Medical Education Service and included in the Common seniority list and now working under Directorate of Medical Education.
- b. Those employees whose whereabouts are not available.
- c. Those employees who are not in service (LWA, Suspension etc.)
- d. The employees included in the Seniority list with erroneous rank position.
- e. The employees included in the seniority list but availed IDT before effecting promotion.
- f. Those employees facing disciplinary action.

9. Those incumbents who are left out from this order for want of whereabouts may submit appeal with documents to prove their claim through proper channel within 10 days from the date of this order. The Head of institutions/District Medical Officers should verify their claim before forwarding the appeals to this office.
10. **Any discrepancy in this order should be brought to the notice of the undersigned within 10 days from the date of this order through DMO(H) for necessary correction.**
11. All the District Medical Officers of Health/Head of Officer/promoted employees are permitted to use the printout of this order published in the official website of DHS for official purposes.
