S. R. O. No. 804/2017.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Services Act, 1968 (19 of 1968) and in supersession of all the existing orders on the subject, the Government of Kerala, hereby make the following Special Rules for the Kerala State Public Health Service, namely:—

RULES

1. *Short title and commencement.*—(1) These rules may be called the Kerala State Public Health Service Special Rules, 2017.
- (2) They shall come into force at once.

2. *Constitution.*—The service shall consist of the following categories of officers, namely:—

- Category 1 .. Technical Assistant Grade I
 Category 2 .. Technical Assistant Grade II/Senior Health Inspector/Health Education Officer/Tutor/Senior Sanitarian.

3. *Method of Appointment.*—Appointment to the various categories of officers mentioned in column (1) of the Table below shall be made by the method of appointment specified in column (2) thereof, namely:—

4. *Qualifications.*—No person shall be eligible for appointment to the categories mentioned in column (1) of the Table below by the method of appointment specified in column (2) unless he possesses the qualification prescribed in the corresponding entry in column (3) thereof:—

Note:— Existing employees having 20 years of service with S.S.L.C. and Health Inspector Course/Sanitary Inspector Course are exempted from passing Plus 2/VHSE or its equivalent and Diploma in Health Inspector Course.

5. *Appointing Authority.*—Government shall be the appointing authority in respect of Category 1 and the Director of Health Services shall be the appointing authority in respect of Category 2.

6. *Probation.*—Every person appointed to any of the categories shall from the date on which he/she joins duty, be on probation for a period of six months on duty within a continuous period of one year.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

In order to widen the knowledge of the public health personnel and to equip them to face the changing situations effectively, it has become necessary to revise the qualification and method of appointment to various posts in the Kerala Health (Public Health Wing) Service. Since the Special Rule for the Kerala Health (Public Health Wing) Service have not been issued so far Government have decided to issue the Special Rules for the posts included in the service in supersession of all the existing orders.
