Sub :- Granting LWA to Nurses for Global Learners Programme in National Health Services, England - Reg.

Ref :- G.O.(Ms)No.196/2018/H&FWD dated, 08.10.2018.

As per the Government order referred above, sanction was accorded to implement the Global Learners Programme, a work based learning programme convened by Health Education England, in the State and Overseas Development and Employment Promotion Consultants(ODEPC) is authorised as the implementing agency of the Programme. The Managing Director, ODEPC is authorised to sign an MOU between ODEPC (on behalf of Government of Kerala) and Health Education England (on behalf of National Health Services, United Kingdom). Permission was also issued to sanction LWA to Nurses working under Director of Health Services/ Director of Medical Education for a period of 3 years to participate in the Global Learners Programme.

Global Learners programme(GLP) is a global education and workplace exchange programme for Nurses/Doctors and other Health Professionals under **Earn, Learn and Return Scheme**. This programme provides innovative and novel working environment for nurses that build and develop international best practices in nursing. Duration of this exchange programme is three years and it aims at preparing nurses to acquire new knowledge and skill and make them ready to lead developments in nursing in their home country.

This is an opportunity for nurses to obtain work experience in international health care settings and global learning. There is a demand for 500 nurses from Kerala. Nurses from both Government and private institutions will get opportunity to get selected for GLP programme. The main advantage is that the internationally trained Government Nurses in the specialty areas will improve nursing care of patients. Therefore, Director of Health Services and Director of Medical Education

are directed to collect and forward the details/willingness of maximum possible number of nurses from the institutions under Health Service/Medical Education for GLP programme, who are interested in participating in this programme. ODEPC, Kerala is entrusted for all the arrangements related to GLP programme. The brochure of GLP is attached for proper guidance.
