ORDER

As per the Government Order read as 1st paper above deputation benefits were sanctioned to Government Servants provided Government are satisfied that the course of study would better equip the Government servant. As per Circular read as 2nd paper above it was clarified that deputation benefit will be allowed only for undergoing courses of study / training prescribed for promotion to posts in the regular line of promotion of the post held by the employees and also in cases where approved scheme exists for such deputation. As per Government order read as 3rd paper above scheme of deputation of medical officers under Health Services for higher studies was issued which has been effective only from 2017-18. As per para 7 of this G.O, DHS should prepare a list of specialties every year to which deputation benefits are to be granted and the number of vacancies that are likely to arise in each specialty with specific remarks on the necessity of granting deputation benefits.

Government are convinced that candidates in the non clinical subjects shall not satisfy the criterion in the circular read above, as the particular course of study / training has not been prescribed for promotion to posts in the regular lines of promotion of the post held by the Officer.

In the circumstances, Government hereby clarify that the courses such as Anatomy, Pharmacology, and Physiology shall not be considered for deputation benefits, other courses for which deputation benefits were eligible earlier may be continued to be so in future also.


