ORDER

The stocking of Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed- Expired Drugs and consumables are becoming an additional burden for the health care institutions. The current dead stock inventory of the above drugs are accumulated utilizing a considerable storage area of the institutions. Hence the Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation, as per the letter read above, has requested to constitute Institutional Level and District Level Condemnation Committees to scrutinize, quantify & certify Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed-Expired Drugs and Consumables which were procured and distributed through Kerala Medical Services Corporation, in order to mobilize the same from the Health Care Institutions, so that the space occupied by the condemnable stock can be better utilized productively to store good shelf life items that are being procured and distributed by the corporation.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute Institution Level Condemnation Committee and District Level Condemnation Committee with the Members as mentioned below, to scrutinize, quantify & certify Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed-Expired Drugs and Consumables which were procured and distributed through Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited.

3. The following steps shall be taken for the disposal of Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed - Expired Drugs and consumables:-

1. The Institution Level Condemnation Committee shall scrutinize, quantify Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed-Expired drugs and consumables at the institution level. The Warehouse Managers shall verify and certify the reports after checking the relevant information available in the DDMS portal.
2. Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed-Expired drugs and consumables, procured through Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited and stored in the institutions shall be mobilized immediately under the expenses of the corporation after due authentication through DDMS.
3. Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/Freezed-Expired drugs and consumables procured and distributed by Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited shall be scrutinized, quantified and certified by the District Level Condemnation Committee. The entire process shall be coordinated by the District Warehouse Manager concerned.
4. The Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited shall hire storage spaces regionally/district wise to store the mobilized items effectively, after doing proper packing and labeling.
5. The Managing Director, Kerala Medical Services Corporation Limited shall consolidate and categorise the Not of Standard Quality/Blacklisted/ Freezed-Expired drugs and consumables stored in the Regional Warehouses and ensure proper disposal.
