**ORDER**

Dr.B Mohammed Asheel, District Programme Manager,  
National Health Mission, Kasaragod was appointed as Executive  
Director, Kerala Social Security Mission on deputation basis for a  
period of one year as per Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> above. Extended  
the period of deputation for further periods as per Government Order  
read as 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> above and the period will expire on 25.08.2019.

2) The Executive Director, Kerala Social Security Mission as  
per the letter read as 5<sup>th</sup> paper has requested for the extension of his term  
of deputation for a further period of one year with effect from

26/8/2018. As per letter read as 4<sup>th</sup> paper above, the Director, Department of Health has forwarded no objection certificate to extend the period of deputation with effect from 26/08/2019.

(3) Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to extend the period of deputation of Dr.Mohammed Asheel, District Programme Manager, National Health Mission, Kasaragod in the post of Executive Director, Kerala Social Security Mission for a further period of one year with effect from 26/08/2019 under usual terms and conditions of deputation.

(4) The Officer on foreign service shall be relieved of his duties on the date of expiry of the sanctioned period unless the competent authority has, with requisite approval, extended the period of deputation, in writing, prior to the date of its expiry. In the event of the officer overstaying he shall be liable to disciplinary action and the period of overstay shall not be counted for the purpose of pension and that any increment due during the period of overstay shall be deferred with cumulative effect, till the date on which the officer rejoins his parent cadre. No ex post facto approval for regularization of overstay on foreign service shall be allowed. The officer shall be precluded from drawing pay and allowances from the date on which the sanctioned term of foreign service expires.
