## INSTRUCTIONS ON COVID-19 VACCINATION OF BEDRIDDEN PATIENTS ABOVE 45 YEARS OF AGE

## No 31/31/F2/2020 H & FW 2020- 31st May 2021

The requests have been received to facilitate vaccination of bedridden patients. In order to ensure uniformity of vaccination to bedridden patient the following guidelines are issued-

- 1. A list shall be prepared of all bedridden patients above the age of 45 years registered in each health facility and whether they are ready for COVID-19 vaccination. In addition, consent must be obtained for each patient to be vaccinated. The participation of the people involved in the daily home care program should be ensured.
- 2. The participation of voluntary organizations (NGOs / CBOs) within the local government limits shall be ensured.
- 3. FHC, PHC staff may seek the help of the staff in CHC and Taluk hospitals for delivery of vaccination services.
- 4. Vaccination shall not be administered by employees who do not have government recognized nursing qualification (must have passed ANM / JPHN course or GNM / BSC nursing course from a recognized institution of the Department of Health). However, vaccination activities shall be planned under the leadership of a community nurse serving within the local government.
- COVID protocol and PPE measures shall be adopted by all vaccination team members. The patient shall be observed for half an hour after the vaccine is given.
- 6. Ensure the services of doctors from Government of Private Hospital for advice in case of any kind of emergency on the days of vaccination. In addition, telemedicine / e-sanjeevani systems operating at the government level shall be utilized.
- 7. All other protocol for vaccination shall be followed up properly.
- 8. The 24-hour toll free number of DISHA- 1056, 0471 2551056 under the State Government will be useful for patients.
