Appeal to Public

Any person with travel history to COVID19 affected countries or person with contact with such a traveler, whether they are having symptoms or not, must remain in home isolation. Avoid social greetings by touching, like hugs or handshake. Don't touch your face, nose and eyes. Use handkerchief while coughing/ sneezing. Use masks, only if you are taking a care of a person with suspected COVID-19 infection, or if you have symptoms. Healthy persons are not supposed to wear medical masks. Those who are wearing masks should know how to use and dispose it properly. N95 masks should not be worn by the public.

WHO has declared the COVID-19 epidemic affecting 118 countries as aPandemic. Due to the inflow of persons from affected countries, Kerala state has strengthened the surveillance and control measures against the disease. 4180 persons are placed under surveillance, out of which 3910 are under home isolation and 270 are admitted in designated isolation facilities. Till date1377samples of suspect cases have been sent for testing out of which results of 953samples came as negative. Testing facilities have been started at Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode Medical Colleges also.

Two more cases have been confirmed as positive 1 from Thrissur and 1 from Kannur. One case from Thiruvananthapuram is awaiting one more confirmation.

In the background of the present COVID-19outbreak, the general public is advised to adhere to health advisories issued by the State Government. Public should follow the cough etiquette by covering the nose and mouth using handkerchief/towel while sneezing/coughing. Do frequent handwashing with soap and water. Those who have arrived from the COVID-19affected countries should remain under strict home isolation.

Complimentary Activities

- 66 training videos has been prepared so far for training of Staff of Health Department and other line departments. The videos have been disseminated through the "Kerala Health Online Training" YouTube channel of the Directorate of Health Services (https://www.youtube.com/c/keralahealthonlinetraining).
- Single window communication channel established with all district control rooms for high priority communications, headed at the state by state control room. Automated data capturing formats for real time data capturing from districts established.
- Human resource management teams have been constituted at the state and district levels. Adequate HR has been ensured for isolation, airport surveillance, transport, isolation services, contact tracing and call centre
- Adequate infrastructure facilities ensured at all designated isolation facilities.
- For providing psychosocial support to the families of suspected persons 143 counsellors have been deployed across the state. 5287 tele counselling services were provided till date.
- In order to strengthen the services provided by the State Call centre, three additional lines have been provided which brings the call centre capacity to a total of six lines.
