<u>ORDER</u>

In partial modification to the GO read above, the IV th point of Operational Guidelines is amended as follows:

"4. If the district is having airport, the health administration will do the arrangements to collect the samples of the international travelers for the COVID testing and get it tested <u>at no costs to the passengers</u>.

The RTPCR test shall be done trough the contracted Laboratories. The Laboratory shall be paid Rs 448/- per test by the Government as per the contract conditions.

If the other approved RTPCR Laboratories are willing to do the RTPCR test at the same rate i.e Rs 448/-, they can also be entrusted with the test samples of the International passengers.

The laboratories shall provide results to the traveler through the Lab Diagnosis Management System (LDMS).

The other mass testing in the clusters, containment zone, etc shall be done through the KMSCL contracted Mobile Laboratories or the RTPCR laboratories for the RTPCR mass testing as when decided by the administration."
