ORDER

The Kerala Administrative Tribunal in its Order dated 23.01.2020 in O A No. 156/2020 filed by Dr. Geetha K, Consultant (O&G), Health Services Department, presently posted at District Hospital, Tirur, Malappuram has directed Government to pass appropriate orders on Annexure A4 representation read as 1st paper above, within time limit after hearing the applicant. Accordingly, the applicant was heard by the undersigned on 22.09.2020.

2.She requested a transfer to Thiruvananthapuram in the light of the circumstances that warranted her presence at her home station. The following were the grounds under which she requested for a transfer to Thiruvananthapuram District:

- i. Her mother was ailing and that she was suffering from various complications including coronary disease and required presence of the applicant.



- ii. Since her child was at a crucial stage of his studies, he required her presence. Since her husband was also working distantly and his chances of obtaining a transfer to the home station was also remote, she was left in a precarious situation.

3. Hence she requested for a transfer to Thiruvananthapuram on compassionate grounds. During hearing also she reiterated more or less the same demands.

4. In her Annexure-A4 representation read as 1st paper above, she pointed out that there are certain vacancies in some hospitals in Thiruvananthapuram District. However, the Director of Health Services in her letter read as 3rd paper above has reported that there existed no vacancy of Consultant (O&G) in any of the Hospitals of Thiruvananthapuram District pointed out by her in Annexure A4 representation. It is also reported that there is no vacancy as such at Kollam District also.

5. However, it is ascertained that presently a vacancy each exists in Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Chirayinkeezh and Taluk Hospital, Parassala. The vacancy at Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Chirayinkeezhu occurred due to the availing of Voluntary Retirement from Service by Dr. Aruna, Consultant (O&G). Vacancy at Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Parassala occurred due the demise of Dr.Geetha K R, Consultant (O&G). In the circumstances, the applicant is transferred and posted at Taluk Head Quarters Hospital, Chirayinkeezhu.

6. The judgement read as 2nd paper above is thus complied with.
