CIRCULAR

Sub:- HSD - Vigilance - Judicial custody death of Rajkumar - recommendations of the Justice K.Narayana Kurup Commission - Guidelines issued - reg.

Ref:- 1. G.O.(MS) No. 47/2021/Home Dept. dated: 17.02.2021. 2. Govt. Lr. No. A2/21/2021/H&FWD, dated: 20.03.2021.

The Government as per the order read (1) above issued directions for further action taken on the basis of the report of the Justice K.Narayana Kurup Commission of enquiry to enquire into the incidents that led to the judicial custody death of Rajkumar aged 49, who was taken into custody by police personnel of Nedumkandam Police Station in Idukki district.

The Government as per the reference read (2) above directed to issue a circular as suggested by the commission. As such the following guide lines as issued.

The Director of Health Services (DHS) and the Director of Medical Education (DME) shall ensure that all persons brought from police custody shall be subjected to an initial screening to unearth the iceberg phenomenon, by directing the medical officers examining the person to order tests such as renal profile, CPK, urine myoglobine, CRP etc; besides ultrasound abdomen to rule out internal injury.

All the medical officers are strictly advised to follow the above directions from Government.
