Notice is hereby given inviting sealed tenders (in duplicate) in separate covers for the supply of (1) Dietary (2) Non-Dietary articles from 01.04.2025 to 31.03.2026 or such other date that may be fixed by the Government to Medical institutions in the state under the control of Directorate of Health Services so as to ready the concerned, not later than 1PM on 30/01/2025.

A list of such institutions can be obtained from the District Medical Officers of Health concerned.

Copies of conditions of tender schedule of dietary articles, Tender form in duplicate and specimen copy of the form of agreement to be executed along with the tender etc. can be had from the respective institutions on production of two chalangans on towards the cost of tender forms as prescribed by the officer in charge of the institution concerned and the other towards the GST together with Solvency Certificate obtained on or after 28-12-2024 (supported by the non Encumbrance Certificate in Original). The Head of Account under which the cost of tender forms had to be remitted to the Government treasury is "0210 – Medical & Public Health 80-General800- other receipts 88-miscellaneous". Remittance of the cost of tender form the dietary and non-dietary articles and that of GST should be in the concerned GST Account. The amount remitted are not refundable under any circumstances.

Each tender must be accompanied by solvency certificate in original clearly indicating to what extent they are solvent from the Tahasildar of the Taluk where they reside along with their tenders as per clause 18 (b) of general conditions of Store Purchase Rules (Govt.letter No.36489/M2/02/H&FWD, dated.09.05.2003) and an attested copy incorporating the encumbrance if any in the

prescribed form obtained on or after 28-12-2024 from the competent revenue authorities. In the absence of the Encumbrance Certificate from the revenue authority the same obtained from the sub registrar to the area concerned should be produced.

The Solvency Certificate for an amount not less than 10% of the tender amount intending tenders should be sent along with the tender agreement executed and signed in Kerala Stamp paper worth Rs. 200/- in the form prescribed in the general conditions of tenders in the Store Purchase Rules
