Praveen Rajendran, Krishna Nandanam, TC34/2625, SNRA-82B, Soorya Nagar, Nettayam, Thiruvananthapuram - 695013 who has been advised by the Kerala Public Service Commission as per their letter read above for appointment to the post of Assistant Surgeon / Casualty Medical Officer is temporarily appointed in the Health Services Department in the scale of pay of Rs. 63700-123700, under clause(i) sub rule (a) of Rule 9 of the General Rules as provided for in Rule10 (b) of those Rules (vide G.O.(P) No.49/74/PD dated 05.03.1974) and posted to to **Community Health Centre Thrithala, Palakkad** subject to the condition that his/her appointment shall be terminated without further notice if the appointing authority is not satisfied with his/her conduct and antecedents on subsequent verification. They shall be eligible for appointment in regular service in accordance with rules only if their character and antecedents are found satisfactory on subsequent verification. The appointment is also subject to Rule 3 (C) of General Rules of Kerala State and subordinate Service Rules, 1958.

2. The candidate is directed to report for duty before the District Medical Officer of Health, Palakkad on or before **22.10.2025** on publishing of the posting order and they are actually permitted to join duty in the respective institution to which the candidates are posted. The candidates should produce the original certificates ie Educational Qualification, Registration, Non Creamy layer, Fitness, PSC Advice Memo, ID proof etc for verification before the District Medical Officer of Health concerned. The District Medical Officer of Health should verify the above documents before permitting the candidates to join duty.

3. In case of candidate pursuing higher studies and willing to seek extension of joining time, their case will be considered as per the provisions specified in Government order read 2nd. Accordingly, those candidates who require extension of joining time up to a maximum of six months from the date of posting order shall submit their application in this regard to this office along with original course certificate and related documents if any and continue their studies. They should also execute a bond at the Directorate of Health Services on or before **22.10.2025** on stamp paper worth Rupees Two Hundred as per circular No.31290/A3/2011/H&FWD dated 20.01.2012 to the effect that they will report for duty on the expiry of joining time and should serve the Government for a minimum period of 5 years after completion of the course, failing which an amount of Rs.5 Lakhs (Rupees Five Lakhs Only) will have to be remitted to Government. In case he/she does not join back, he/she shall be debarred from any further employment in Government Services and such names should be informed to Kerala Public Service Commission.

4. In case of candidates pursuing higher studies and require extension of joining time beyond six months, they should join duty at the posted station and avail Leave without Allowance further for the requisite period to complete the course in accordance with the provisions laid down in Appendix XII B Part I KSR and relieve from duty only after receiving No Objection Certificate from the Appointing Authority. They will also be eligible for extension of joining time up to 45 days if required.

5. In case of candidates pursuing compulsory bonded obligation (Senior Residency) as a part of their higher studies and require extension of joining time, their case will be considered as per the provisions specified in Government order read 4th. Those who require extension of joining time up to a maximum of six months should also follow the same procedure mentioned in Para 3. Those who require extension of joining time beyond six months for completing their Senior residency, they should join duty at the posted station and avail Leave without Allowance only after receiving No Objection Certificate from the Appointing Authority. They will also be eligible for extension of joining time up to 45 days if required.

6. Candidates already employed in any other department in State Government service will be permitted to join duty only after obtaining relieving order issued by the competent authority. In case of requirement of extension of joining time beyond 45 days in such cases on administrative reasons, extension up to a maximum of 60 days from the date of appointment order will be admissible. Application for such extension of joining time beyond 45 days shall be submitted with recommendation from the present appointing authority.

7. In case of candidates employed in Central Government service/Other State service/State & Central Public sector organizations/Banks, extension of joining time upto 90 days will be admissible on request and also if application is submitted on proper grounds. Extension of joining time up to a maximum of 45 days will be admissible in normal course if required, for applications submitted with proper reasons and also on the condition that the appointing authority is satisfied with the reason specified for extension of joining time.

8. The application for correction of date of birth, if any required should be made by the candidates within five years from the date of entry in service.

9. The appointment is subject to Part II Rule 7 of General rules of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules 1958.

10. In the case of those candidates who fail to join duty within stipulated time, their appointment will be cancelled and the vacancy will be reported to Kerala Public Service Commission as 'Not Joining Duty.'
